Scriptures for Today

2 Kings 13:14–18 / 2 Kings 2:11–12 / 2 Kings 6:15–17 / Matthew 23:37 / Matthew 16:19

Opening Reflection — Follow-Up From Last Week

Last week's call to action was:

“Intentionally ask the Lord to remove one ‘veil’ that has kept you from seeing Christ within you — a lie, a label, a fear, or a sense of disqualification. Replace it with the truth of your identity: Christ in you — the hope of glory. Then consciously reveal His goodness to one person through encouragement, kindness, or presence.”

How did you experience the Lord removing a veil this past week? Where did you intentionally reveal His goodness to someone?

Discussion Points

1. Victory Is Within Reach — Not Automatically in Hand

Pastor Stewart said God's promises can be *in reach* but not yet *in your hand*. **Where have you sensed God's promise near you, yet not fully experienced it?**

2. Desperation Drives Us Toward Divine Intervention

2 Kings 13:14 The king came to Elisha because he knew he could not win on his own. **Where have you reached the point of “I can't fix this myself”?**

3. Recognizing When You Need Heaven's Help

The king cried, *“My father, my father — the chariots and horsemen of Israel!”* He remembered divine intervention. **What past moment of God's intervention do you need to remember today?**

4. The Transfer of Authority — Elisha's Hand on the King's Hand

Laying on of hands symbolized consecration and empowerment. **Where do you need God to “place His hand over your hand” in this season?**

5. The Arrow of the Lord's Deliverance

A normal arrow became **the Lord's arrow** only after the king acted. **What ordinary action in your life might become supernatural once God touches it?**

6. God Takes Responsibility After We Take Responsibility

Pastor said: *“God takes responsibility because you have taken responsibility.”* **Where is God waiting for you to pick up the bow before He empowers it?**

7. Partial Commitment Leads to Partial Victory

The king struck the ground only three times — and received only partial victory. **Where have you settled for partial commitment and therefore partial breakthrough?**

8. Blessing Requires Cooperation

Pastor taught: *“We are workers together with Him.”* **What step of cooperation is God asking you to take right now?**

9. Unbelief Limits What God Will Do

Mark 6:5–6; Matthew 23:37 Unbelief doesn't stop God's power — it stops His decisions. **Where is unbelief quietly limiting what God wants to do in your life?**

10. Heaven Is Waiting on Earth

Matthew 16:19 “Whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven...” **What action on earth do you need to take so heaven can respond?**

Closing Call to Action

This week, identify one area where you need supernatural victory — and intentionally “pick up the bow.” Take one concrete step of cooperation with God. Sanctify your natural action by inviting His hand over yours, and strike the ground with full commitment — not partial effort.
