1. What from last week’s message on Creation/Formation did you allow God to work on in you during the week?
2. What was one key truth, phrase, or moment from this week’s message—Governed—that stood out to you? Why?
3. God Wants Relationship, Not Religion
 - a. “He wants sons, not servants... citizens, not Christians... relationships, not religion.”
 - b. How does this challenge the way many believers approach God?
 - c. Where do you still relate to God through duty instead of relationship?
4. God Governs—He Does Not Control
 - a. What’s the difference between being controlled and being governed?
 - b. How have control-based religious ideas shaped your view of God?
5. Dominion: Representing God on Earth
 - a. What does it mean to be God’s visible representative?
 - b. Where do you sense God calling you to step into healthy dominion—governing, leading, managing, stewarding?
6. The government of God is not in the mind or desires, it is in me – in my chest.
 - a. How do you discern the difference between God’s governance and your own desires or thoughts?

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- b. What practices help you listen from the “deepest person” rather than the surface?
- 7. Maturity and Ambassadorship - *“A controlled person cannot mature... Maturity is becoming an ambassador of God’s government.”*
 - a. What does spiritual maturity look like in the context of God’s government?
 - b. How can you represent God’s government in a way others would want to accept it?
- 8. God’s Desire to Dwell With Us - *God’s long-standing desire to “tabernacle or dwell with man.”*
 - a. How does seeing God as a Father who wants to dwell with you reshape your daily life?
- 9. Living on Earth as It Is in Heaven - *“Thy Kingdom come... that what is done in Heaven would be done in you, and consequently in the earth.”*
 - a. What would change in your life if you truly lived governed by Heaven’s order?
 - b. What area of your life most needs Heaven’s government right now?
- 10. Call to Action
 - a. This week, choose one area of your personal sovereignty—your will, desires, or decisions—and intentionally place it under God’s government.
