1. Discuss last week's call to action:

Last Week's Closing Call to Action: practice "building His Church" by bringing God to one person where they are. Serve them, encourage them, or meet a need — not to get them to a place, but to bring Christ to them through your presence, love, and obedience. Let someone experience Jesus through you.

3. What is the fallacy of the "only human" or "just a sinner" mindset? How does living this mindset impact you and the body of Christ.
4. What is the significance of praying "Your Kingdom come, your will be done on earth"?
 - a. Why is this prayer profound and comprehensive?
 - b. How is our real need to follow God's purpose on this Earth.
5. What does it mean that our inheritance is the human image of God that He has placed into every human?
 - a. What is this image?
 - b. Why did God choose it this way?
 - c. Are we grateful?
6. What is the significance of our own personal sovereignty - the ability to make choices?
 - a. How does this relate to our inheritance of the image of God placed within us?
 - b. What does it relate to our mind and desires, or innermost being?
7. Are we attempting to become Jesus, or become human as Jesus is human?
 - a. What does it mean to be human as Jesus is human?

8. Discuss **II Cor. 5:17**
9. How do we awaken and cultivate the image of God placed inside of us?
 - a. Is this necessary to do the will of God on earth?
 - b. Why do we see the Kingdom when the image is awakened?
10. Discuss **I Cor. 2: 6-7**
 - a. Why is it important that we are born from above?
 - b. How does this allow us – in our humanness – to do the will of God?
11. Discuss **Acts 10: 38 ; Luke 4:18- 19**
 - a. Does God want us to do His will the way Jesus did?
 - b. What is the Kingdom value system placed in us when we are born of the Spirit?
 - c. How does the Father mature this human image after we are reborn of the Spirit?
 - d. How are we becoming the image of God in Christ?
 - e. Comment on **“when Christ is replicated in me, I am not Jesus, I am human as Jesus is Human.”**
12. Why is it important we find time to be alone with God and let him know we are desirous of our humanity being awakened and available to Him?
 - a. How does this image of God become our personal sovereignty?
13. Discuss **Romans 8:1-13.**
 - a. Do we really comprehend what is working inside of us when His Spirit comes and takes residence in our lives?
 - b. What are we going to do with what we have?
14. Discuss **Gal. 5:13 – 15**
 - a. How do we become human as God intended when He governs our lives? Is this a choice – act of our personal sovereignty?
 - b. Can we allow agape to govern our lives? How does this transform us into the image of Christ?
15. Pray: Lord – here I am. Use me.
16. **This week’s Closing Call to Action:** This week, consider how the image of God inside of you allows you to do His will, and how you can be human as Jesus was Human and be Human the way God intended you to be.
