1. What challenged you from the message?
 2. What questions arose because of the message or something that was said in the message?
 3. What is the definition or meaning of the term, personal sovereignty?
 - a. Who decides your inner world, boundaries, and core principles?
 - b. How does “my” personal sovereignty work?
 4. To live in God’s will, who must have the greatest influence?
 5. Is it true that all human beings are made in God’s image? Is there a “vacuum” in every person that must be filled? Filled with what?
 6. Discuss the kingdom view: He is, I am, we are.
 - a. When referring to God as He, what is He?
 7. What does it mean: We are becoming what we already are.
 8. Since we are not “God,” but made in His image, what does that make us?
 9. Read John 3:3 and discuss the born again and born from above concept.
 10. Read Hebrews 12:12-24 and discuss the location of the New Jerusalem. What is the New Jerusalem?
 11. How important is it to know and understand our I am when it comes to the governance of our personal sovereignty?
 12. What are some things that people attempt to fill their God-shaped vacuum in their being?
 - a. When they do this, is it because they don’t have a true self-image that God has for them?
 13. As believers in the Son of God, Jesus Christ, are we being conformed to the image of Christ, the true I Am?
 - a. Is this what was meant when Pastor made the statement: We are becoming what we already are?

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14. When our I am is being restored, is this how God accomplishes His will on earth? Is this the mystery or secret that has been ignored by mankind?
15. Our image was injured by Adam, but is what we “see” about ourselves, the external part of who we are, simply the container that holds the actual image of God?
16. Read Colossians 2:11-14 and discuss how water baptism symbolizes the circumcision of the heart and how this relates to cutting away the old man, the old Adam nature and image.
17. Discuss: To be fully aware of the strength and the purpose of our personal sovereignty requires our embrace of God’s governing purpose.
18. Read Galatians 5:14 & 16-17. What does it mean that God is Agape, God is Love?
19. Discuss the illustration of the umpire in a sports game, and its relevance to God’s governing force for our lives. Does He control our lives, or does He want to govern our lives?
20. Read Romans 14:17-18 and discuss living in the Kingdom realities.
21. Can we live?
 - a. In His Name. What does that mean?
 - b. By His Grace. What does that mean?
 - c. For His Purpose. What does that mean?
22. Read Ephesians 1:17-18 and discuss living as God’s inheritance.
