Unveiling the Christ Within You — Part 2: *Pastor Stewart Farley*

Scriptures for Today

Ephesians 1:10 / 2 Corinthians 3:2–6 / 2 Corinthians 3:7–14 / 2 Corinthians 3:14–16

Opening Reflection — Follow-Up From Last Week

Last week's call to action was:

“Use your God-given freedom to choose one deliberate act of surrender — not forced, not out of fear, but out of love. Lay down one preference, one fear, one entitlement, or one area of control, and choose the Father’s will with your whole heart, soul, and mind.”

How did you intentionally surrender this past week? Where did you notice Christ reshaping your destiny through that choice?

1. Heaven & Earth Coming Together in Us

Ephesians 1:10 Pastor Stewart emphasized that new creation is not only being born again — it is heaven and earth meeting in a person. **How does seeing yourself as the meeting place of heaven and earth reshape your identity?**

2. You Are God’s Epistle — The Word Made Flesh in You

2 Corinthians 3:2–6 When God writes His Word on your heart, it becomes alive in you. **Where have you recently sensed God’s Word becoming “flesh” — lived out — in your daily life?**

3. The Veil of the Old Covenant

2 Corinthians 3:7–14 Moses veiled his face so Israel wouldn’t see the fading glory. Pastor said the modern church often puts veils on people by preaching law instead of Christ. **What “veils” have kept you from seeing your true identity in Christ?**

4. Condemnation Shuts Down Faith

Pastor taught that the enemy’s weapon is condemnation — not temptation. **Where has condemnation tried to define you, and how has Christ confronted that lie?**

5. Christ in You — The Hope of Glory

Colossians 1:27 God's glory is His goodness, and Christ in you is the hope of that goodness being revealed. **What part of Christ's goodness do you most desire to reveal to others?**

6. What You Look At, You Become

Pastor said: *"If your God is mean and vicious, you'll have a mean and vicious attitude yourself."*
How has your view of God shaped your attitude, relationships, or spiritual life?

7. The Old Covenant Fades — The New Covenant Reveals Identity

The old covenant disqualified people; Jesus tore down the wall and removed the veil. **Where do you still feel "disqualified," and what truth removes that veil?**

8. Spiritual Warfare Is Announcing Freedom

Pastor said spiritual warfare is not devil-fighting — it is announcing to powers that God has redeemed humanity. **How does this change the way you think about spiritual warfare?**

9. The Law Was Nailed to the Cross

Colossians 2:13-15 The handwriting of requirements (the law) was nailed to the cross, disarming condemnation. **What changes in your life when you truly believe condemnation has been disarmed?**

10. Walking With Him in the Cool of the Day

Pastor said that when the veils are removed and identity is revealed, believers begin walking with God in joy, peace, and relationship. **What would it look like for you to walk with Christ more relationally and less religiously this week?**

Closing Call to Action

This week, intentionally ask the Lord to remove one "veil" that has kept you from seeing Christ within you — a lie, a label, a fear, or a sense of disqualification. Replace it with the truth of your identity: *Christ in you — the hope of glory*. Then consciously reveal His goodness to one person through encouragement, kindness, or presence.

Before we dismiss, let's make a commitment to each other and the Lord to do this.
