 - a. Do we tend to hang on to our Adamic nature – like Stewart's illustration of someone keeping a loved one's personal effects after they have passed on?
5. What is it to manifest something? Can we manifest both the positive and negative – the old Adamic nature and our new self in Christ?
6. What did you learn from the parable of the five coats?
7. How does pain manifest in Adam?
8. How does pain manifest in Christ?
9. What is the source of pain, and our response to pain, and how does it relate to our tripartite nature? Stemming from the tripartite nature of human beings.
 - a. Read and comment 1 Thessalonians 5:22-23 TPT

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10. Must the mind, the will, and emotions be connected to and engaged with the spirit as well as with the body?
 - a. Read and Comment 1 Corinthians 14:15 TPT; Hebrews 4:12 NKJV?
11. In a pre-rescued State – While we are in Adam – in an Adamic state, how does pain manifest in each part of our tripartite nature?
 - a. Physical Pain • Soulical Pain • Spiritual Pain
12. How does the manifestation of pain change as we are rescued and as we mature?
 - a. Read and comment 2 Corinthians 5:17 NKJV
 - b. Read and comment on Romans 12:2 NKJV
13. How do we reorient – renew our minds from the flesh to the spirit?
14. What is the importance of subordinating our will to the will of God?
15. How does this provide access to the Kingdom?
16. How did Jesus manifest Pain?
17. What is the importance of the interplay between Matthew 27:46 NKJV and Psalm 22?
 - a. Was this a scripture of abandonment, or, of faith and hope? Have you heard it taught differently? Can the two teachings be reconciled?
 - b. Can we manifest Pain in the same way Jesus did? How?
 - c. What can the manifestation of pain teach us about God's willingness to allow us to experience pain?

 - a. How does this relate to the Parable of the 5 Coats?
 - b. How is this illustrative of Jesus? How is it a guide to our own way of manifesting God's love?
