What Does The Bible Say?

14 But how can they call on him to save them unless they believe in him? And how can they believe in him if they have never heard about him? And how can they hear about him unless someone tells them? 15 And how will anyone go and tell them without being sent? That is why the Scriptures say, "How beautiful are the feet of messengers who bring good news!" (Romans 10:14–15 NLT)

Why don't we share our faith more?

- We feel hypocritical? We don't live <u>good</u> enough lives.
- We feel we do not know enough about the <u>Bible</u>.
- We don't have a <u>plan</u> on what to say.

How Can You Obey?

First, tell people what you were like <u>before</u> you started to follow Christ.

- What was your <u>focus</u> in life?
- How was your <u>thinking</u> faulty?

Second, explain what happened - how following Jesus made sense to you.

- Your current path was leading to <u>destruction</u>.
- You knew something was <u>missing</u> in your life.
- You felt worthless or <u>unlovable</u>.
- You started thinking about <u>death</u>.

Third, how has following Jesus <u>changed</u> your life?

- Describe how God's forgiveness, love and promise of everlasting life has <u>affected</u> you.
- Tell them how it's changed your <u>perspective</u> on who you are and why you're here.
- Tell them how embracing the <u>gospel</u> has changed you.
 Notice that I have not given any <u>Bible</u> verses at all.
 Many people do not accept the Bible as their religious source. People can argue about the Bible, but cannot deny your <u>experiences</u>.

Fourth, ask them if they ever considered following Christ. You choose to believe what Christ did on the <u>cross</u> and after He arose from the dead. 16 "For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life. (John 3:16 NLT)

I don't believe the Bible is from God?

- What if they say I don't believe the Bible is from God?
- Reliable eye-witness testimony confirms the history of most of the Bible.
- Archaeology confirms the history of the Bible.
- Fulfilled prophecies confirm the Divine origin of the Bible.
- The consistent message confirms the Divine origin of the Bible.

What if they say - I don't believe the creation story or Jonah and the whale?
