Why should you share with others how the Holy Spirit is changing you?

This week we are looking at how we are to share with others how the process of becoming like Christ is changing us.

The apostle Paul said in 2 Corinthians 5:13 that we become a new person, the old life is gone, and a new life has begun.

Paul also said in Galatians 6:12 that what counts is that we have been transformed into a new creation.

So why should we share how we are changing with others?

The simplest answer is that Jesus commands us to tell others. In Acts 1:8, Jesus said that the Holy Spirit will give us power to witness to others about Jesus.

God does not ask us to be a theologian that can answer everyone’s questions, but just to be a witness. A witness is just one who shares what he or she saw or experienced.

A changed life with Christ always starts with repentance. Repentance means you have a regret for following your own path, and now you want to follow Christ’s path. You are now much more interested in helping build His kingdom than building your own.

The disciples were sent out by Jesus in Mark 6:12, and they told everyone to repent of their sins and turn to God.

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
