THE FIVE LOVE LANGUAGES — A Simple Tool for Loving Others Well
The "Five Love Languages," introduced by Gary Chapman, offer a helpful way
to think about how people most naturally feel loved. It's not a rigid system, but
a practical framework that reminds us to pay attention to what speaks to each
person's heart. Used wisely, this list can help us see that people experience
love in different ways—and it encourages us to communicate care
intentionally, not just in the ways that come naturally to us. It's a simple
reminder to love others in ways that truly build them up.

Words of Affirmation: taking the time to reflect so you can verbalize relevant praise, write a note of encouragement, or speak with timely appreciation Quality Time: giving someone your full attention through conversation or intentional moments together – being in proximity without distraction counts! Thoughtful Gifts: giving tangible tokens, gifts, experiences or gestures that require, and express, thoughtfulness. It's the gift and the thought that matters! Acts of Service: helping with tasks, meeting needs in to lighten someone's load, showing awareness of their burdens

Physical Touch: expressing care & commitment with appropriate touch; hugs, a high five, intentional proximity, etc
