⁶ And this time **their nets were so full of fish they began to tear!**

...Jesus replied to Simon, “**Don’t be afraid! From now on you’ll be fishing for people!**” ¹¹

...A funeral procession...The young man who had died was a widow’s only son, and a large crowd from the village was with her. ¹³When the Lord saw her, **his heart overflowed with compassion**...he walked over to the coffin and touched it, and the bearers stopped.

“Young man,” he said, “I tell you, get up.” ¹⁵Then the dead boy sat up and began to talk! And **Jesus gave him back to his mother...**

Gospel simply means ‘good news’ and *The Gospels* are the 4 back-to-back biographies of Jesus’ life at the beginning of the New Testament. They are named after their authors and cover similar material (John is the most unique) but they are aimed at different audiences and written with different motivations. You’ll notice more than just the personality of the author in the differences – you’ll see the identity of Jesus shaded in different hues.

note: Remember when you see things happen again in Mark’s gospel after reading it in Matthew’s – the event is being described from another perspective, not happening again. Jesus isn’t dying multiple times!
