DEVOTED:	to persevere in some activity or cause to the point of devotion
DEVOTION:	the state of being ardently dedicated and loyal

ACTS 2:41–47 NLT

Those who believed what Peter said were baptized and added to the church that day—about 3,000 in all.

All the believers devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, and to fellowship, and **to sharing in meals** (including the Lord's Supper), and to prayer. A deep sense of awe came over them all, and the apostles performed many miraculous signs and wonders. And all the believers met together in one place and shared everything they had. They sold their property and possessions and shared the money with those in need. They worshiped together at the Temple each day, met in homes for the Lord's Supper, and **shared their meals with great joy and generosity** - all the while praising God and enjoying the goodwill of all the people. And each day the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved.
