#### 1 PETER 2:11-17

#### KNOW YOUR IDENTITY | YOU ARE NOT OF THIS WORLD.

11 Dear friends, I urge you, *as foreigners and exiles*, to abstain from sinful desires, which wage war against your soul.

LIVE WITH AN ETERNAL PERSPECTIVE | LET YOUR LIFE LEAD THEM TO HIM.

12 Live such good lives among the pagans that, though they accuse you of doing wrong, they may see your good deeds and glorify God on the day he visits us.

HONOR GOD IN SUBMISSION TO AUTHORITY | OBEDIENCE ALIGNS US WITH HIS WILL. 13 *Submit yourselves for the Lord's sake* to every human authority: whether to the emperor, as the supreme authority, 14 or to governors, who are sent by him to punish those who do wrong and to commend those who do right.

**SILENCE THE ACCUSER** | DOING GOOD SPEAKS LOUDER THAN WORDS. 15 For it is God's will that *by doing good you should silence the ignorant talk* of foolish people.

## YOUR FREEDOM BRINGS RESPONSIBILITY | YOU BELONG TO GOD.

16 *Live as free people*, but do not use your freedom as a cover-up for evil; *live as God's slaves.* 17 Show proper respect to everyone, love the family of believers, *fear God, honor the emperor.*
