REVELATION 4:6-11

THE HALLELUJAH PSALMS

PSALMS 146-150

PRAISE: hā-lāl: v; praise, cheer, boast in, brag on, extol, i.e., extol the greatness or excellence of a person; boast in, praise, glory in, i.e., express words of excellence, with a focus on the confidence one has in the person.

PSALM 146:1-2

¹ Praise the LORD.

Praise the LORD, my soul.

² I will praise the LORD all my life;
I will **sing** praise to my God as long as I live...

PSALM 147:1, 5, 7

¹ Praise the LORD.

How good it is to **sing** praises to our God,
how pleasant and fitting to praise him! ...

⁵ Great is our Lord and mighty in power;
his understanding has no limit...

⁷ **Sing** to the LORD with grateful praise;
make music to our God **on the harp**...

PSALM 148:1-2, 7, 11-

¹ Praise the LORD.

Praise the LORD from the heavens;
praise him in the heights above.

² Praise him, all his angels;
praise him, all his heavenly hosts...

⁷ **Praise the LORD from the earth...**

¹¹ **kings** of the earth and all nations,
you **princes** and all **rulers** on earth,

¹² **young men and women,**
old men and children.

¹³ Let them praise the name of the LORD,
for his name alone is exalted;
his splendor is above the earth and the heavens.

¹⁴ And he has raised up for his people a
horn, the praise of all his faithful servants,
of Israel, the people close to his heart.

PSALM 149:1-6, 9

¹ Praise the LORD.

Sing to the LORD a new song, his praise
in the assembly of his faithful people.

² Let Israel rejoice in their Maker;
let the people of Zion be glad in their King.

³ Let them **praise his name with dancing**
and make music to him with **timbrel and harp**.

⁴ For the LORD takes delight in his people;
he crowns the humble with victory.

⁵ Let his faithful people rejoice in this
honor and **sing** for joy on their beds.

⁶ May the praise of God be in their
mouths...this is the glory of all his faithful
people. Praise the LORD.

PSALM 150

¹ Praise the LORD.

Praise God in his sanctuary;
praise him in his mighty heavens.

² Praise him for his acts of power;
praise him for his surpassing greatness.

³ Praise him with the sounding of the
trumpet,

praise him with the **harp** and **lyre**,

⁴ praise him with **timbrel** and **dancing**,
praise him with the **strings** and **pipe**,

⁵ praise him with the clash of **cymbals**,
praise him with resounding **cymbals**.

⁶ Let everything that has **breath** praise the
LORD.
