vs. CONTINUATIONISM

- I. _______ a doctrine that spiritual gifts such as speaking in tongues, prophecy and healing ceased with the Apostolic Age
 - A. Arguments from Scripture
 - 1. **Ephesians 2:20** the church is built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets...
 - 2. **Jude 3** delivered to the saints, once for all
 - 3. 1 Corinthians 13:8-10 prophecy, tongues, knowledge cease...
 - 4. **Hebrews 1:1-2** Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son
 - B. Objections
 - 1. Not a scripture heavy doctrine
 - 2. This doctrine was not generally developed until the 1500s
 - 3. The gifts are taught to the New Testament churches
 - 4. You have to explain around many New Testament verses to avoid spiritual gifts (1 Cor. 14:1)
- **II. Continuationism** a Christian theological belief that the gifts of the Holy Spirit, the spiritual gifts, have continued to the present age and will continue until the return of Jesus Christ
 - A. Arguments from Scripture
 - 1. **1 Corinthians 1:7** so that you are not lacking in any gift, as you wait for the revealing of our Lord Jesus Christ,
 - 2. **John 14:12** greater works than Jesus
 - 3. 1 Corinthians 12:4-11 varieties of gifts, same Spirit. Spirit gives to each as He wills.
 - 4. 1 Corinthians 12:27-30 earnestly desire the greater gifts
 - 5. *1 Corinthians 13:9-10* until that which is perfect comes
 - 6. **Ephesians 4:11-16** until we attain full measure of Christ
 - 7. *Acts 2:16-18 Joel prophecy*
 - 8. Throughout the New Testament there is description, discussion, demonstration and emphasis of spiritual gifts (Rom. 12; 1 Cor. 12-14; Acts 2, 8,10,13,19; Gal. 3; 1 Thess. 5)
 - B. Objections
 - 1. The authority of prophecy
 - 2. The judgment of prophecy (Deut. 13; 18)
 - 3. Abuse / Messy
 - 4. We do not see healings, the miraculous, as spoken of in the Apostolic Age

Cessationism	vs Continuationism
Miracles, prophecy and tongues has ceased	Miracles, prophecy and tongues continues on
Such gifts only establish apostle's authority	Such gifts have several purposes (common good)
Don't see gifts after the apostles' time	Those other than apostles had such gifts
Foundation laid makes gifts irrelevant	Christ's fullness is distributed through gifts

III. Compromise: Gifts have not "ceased" but are not "normative"

- A. Question 1: Why then should we earnestly desire these gifts? (1 Corinthians 12:27-31)
- B. Question 2: Why shouldn't these gifts be normative? (Matthew 17:14-20)

I. THIS WOULD BE EASIER IF YOU STOPPED STRUGGLING.

Amos 3:3

Can two walk together unless they are agreed?
