- **Plan:** Make a plan to incorporate regular family devotions and prayer time.

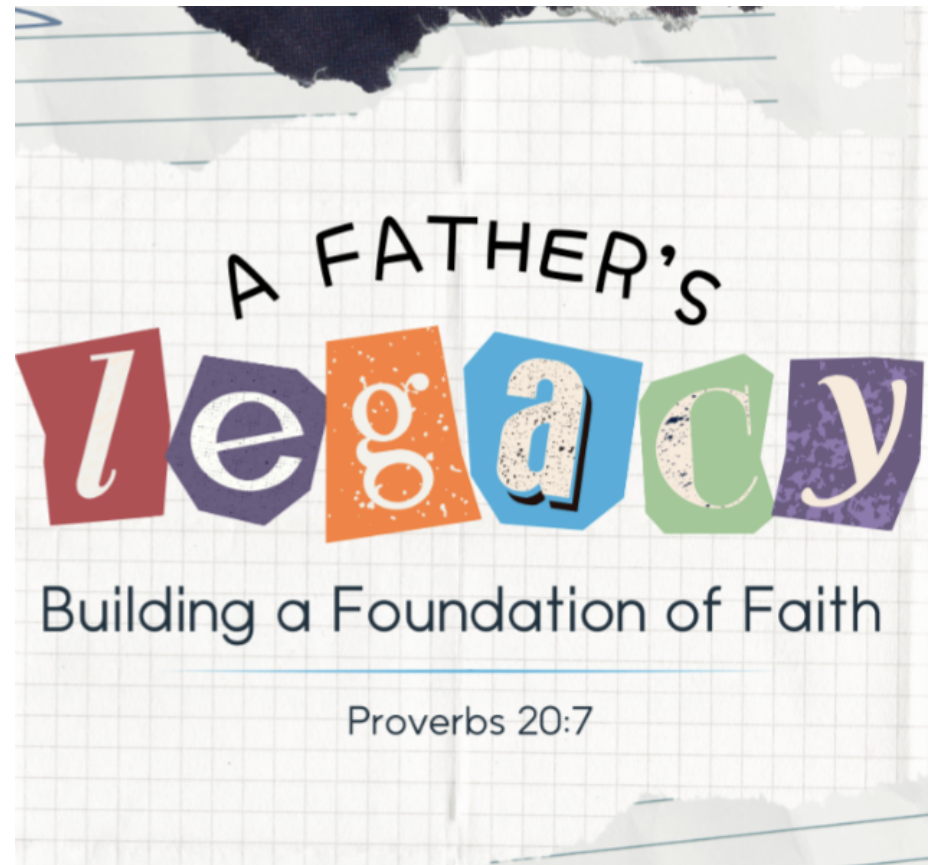
