Text: Acts 22:21-23

When things do not work out as we hope or plan, that can be difficult to handle. When it comes to how others respond to our words or actions regarding Jesus, the negative can be very hard to receive. In our text, Paul's witness, which is an appeal to his audience to see Jesus as the Messiah, is rejected with outrage-even cries for his death!
