### Message Outline

Message: The Difference in *Our Families*

Series: Relationships: *The Difference Jesus Makes!*

Text: Ephesians 6:1-4

Introduction: If *Jesus* is who He says He is, and if *we* have Jesus in our lives like we say we do, *then something should be different* about us that stands out *in* and *to* this world.

- I. **When Love & Respect Overflow (5:33)**
  - a. Marriage is meant to create more than children.
  - b. Married / Single = *Overflow nurturing love.*
- II. **Tremendous Potential (6:1-3)**
  - a. Healing generational brokenness (v.1)
  - b. Realizing what we have. (v.2)
  - c. Reaching beyond what we began with. (v.3)
- III. **The Impact Family Has on Each of Us (6:4)**
  - a. Passing a baton that marries as one declaration and demonstration.
  - b. The home is a picture of the nurturing that can happen in a church community.
- IV. **Conclusion & Application-*In Christ, we can pour into those going after us to become a generation that calls upon the Name of the Lord!***

### Going Deeper Questions for Application

- Walk through all four points of the message. Which one stood out to you the most and why?

- In what ways can marriage create? What is love and respect, and how can they overflow?
- What generational issues did you inherit? Have you found healing in Jesus?
