## Week of Prayer Day 1 - Sunday

### Opening Prayer

### Scripture

### Reflection

To *trust in the Lord* wholeheartedly means one should not rely (lean) on their understanding, for human insights are never enough. God's ways are incomprehensible (Isa. 55:8-9; Rom. 11:33-34); yet He is trustworthy. All the wisdom a person may acquire can never replace the need for full trust in God's superior ways.

As a person trusts in the Lord and acknowledges Him, they find that God makes their *paths straight*. This means more than guidance; it means God removes the obstacles, making a smooth path or way of life, bringing one to the appointed goal.

In the hustle and bustle of leadership responsibilities, it's easy for our leaders to become overwhelmed, relying solely on their own understanding and wisdom. However, God's Word reminds us that true trust is found in leaning on Him. We pray, Lord, that our leaders turn to You with open hearts, seeking Your guidance in every decision they make.

As leaders navigate the challenges, we believe that God will grant them discernment to distinguish between right and wrong, courage to make difficult decisions, and humility to seek counsel from those around them. God invites leaders to submit their plans, ambitions,

and visions to Him, aligning their will with His, knowing that His ways are higher, and His wisdom surpasses all understanding.
