SCRIPTURE READING Acts 16:6-15 CLM Twinkle Gordon

They went through the region of Phrygia and Galatia, having been forbidden by the Holy Spirit to speak the word in Asia. When she and her household were baptized, she urged us, saying, "If you have judged me to be faithful to the Lord, come and stay at my home." And she prevailed upon us.
