FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Church Family,

What makes a family successful?

We might answer that question in many different ways. We might talk about spending time together, communicating well, setting boundaries, making good decisions, or simply trying to be there for one another. All of those things matter.

But as followers of Jesus, we believe there is something even more important: **the values that shape the way our family lives.**

Our culture often tells us that success means becoming independent. But the Bible gives us a different picture. God's design is that we belong to one another. Parents invest in children. Children honor parents. Grandparents pass faith to grandchildren. Brothers and sisters care for one another. And when someone in the family is struggling, we don't simply say, "That's your problem." We say, "We're family. How can we help?"

**Family values aren't merely what we say we believe.
Family values are what we're willing to live out.**

The same is true of our faith. We can say we love Jesus, but eventually our values show up in the way we spend our time, the way we treat our spouse, the way we raise our children, the way we respond when someone hurts us, and the way we serve people outside our home.

My prayer is that when these two weeks are over, we'll be asking a very personal question: **“What kind of family am I helping to build?”**

Because the greatest legacy we can leave our children isn't a house, a bank account, or even a family name. It's a faith that outlives us.

So, mark these two Sundays on your calendar, invite your family, and begin praying now about what God might want to change—not just **in** your family, but through your family.

I believe God wants to build families that don't simply survive the pressures of our culture but become living testimonies of His grace, His love, and His transforming power.

Let's build a family legacy that points the next generation to Jesus.

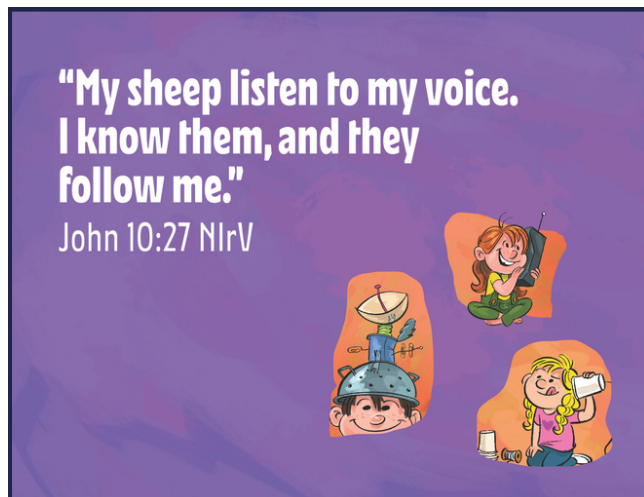
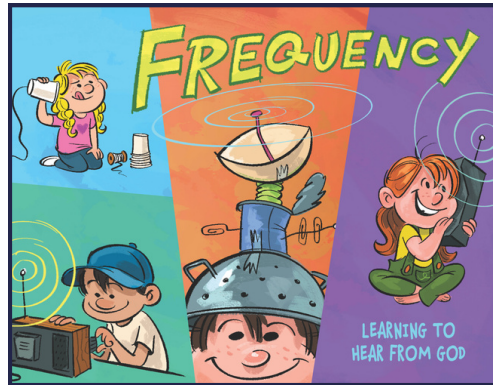

Pastor Roy gave us a unique daily reading plan for our Bibles, starting back in January. If you've been following the schedule he gives us each month, then you've been reading Numbers and Deuteronomy this past month of August. We're finishing up Deuteronomy and I'm so glad God sent Jesus to us to show us a better way and to give the final sacrifice for sin. In those days before Jesus, God gave very explicit rules to the Israelites and if you failed to obey, you were destined to be stoned to death to "purge Israel of such evil." (NLT) Can you just imagine what this world would be like today if we were disciplined as such today? Actually the world would probably be better off, but there might be millions fewer of us! I tried to analyze why we had to read about how strict God was to them and my own opinion is that by reading how it was, we would recognize with full force the marvelous impact of the sacrifice of Jesus's life when He gave the ultimate sacrifice so we could live with freedom to live our life how we wanted but knowing there would be our own sacrifice at death if we didn't follow HIM! We would sacrifice a beautiful life eternally with Him and suffer eternally in hell! So today think about that and if you need to make a change in lifestyle, please consider praying for forgiveness and submission to following Jesus or talk to one of our awesome pastors!

Now we're in the month of September with school sessions beginning for another year. Let us keep our young children in prayer as they trot off to school that they would be safe from any harm that could happen, which could include wrong lessons about sexuality as well as physical violence. Let's pray that our leaders will not try to sway our children's minds down a wrong path. Don't forget that kids will sometimes idolize their teachers and believe what they say despite what you may teach them!

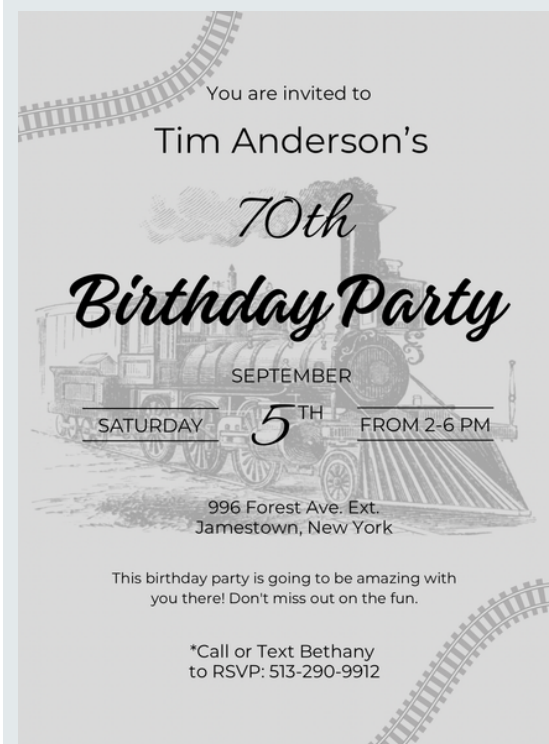

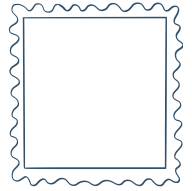
