From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Church Family,

As Thanksgiving approaches, we're reminded once again of how powerful gratitude really is. Not just the kind of thankfulness that appears once a year around the dinner table, but the deep, steady gratitude that changes how we see life every day.

When Paul wrote to the Thessalonians, he said, "Give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus" (1 Thessalonians 5:18). Notice that little word—in.

Paul doesn't say to give thanks *for* all circumstances, but *in* them. Gratitude isn't about pretending everything is perfect; it's about recognizing that God is still faithful, even when life isn't easy.

A thankful heart doesn't deny the struggles—it declares that God is greater than them. It remembers that behind every blessing and even behind every burden, there is a God who is working for our good and His glory.

This season, as you gather with family or friends, take a moment to reflect not only on what you have, but on who you have. You have a Savior who loves you, a God who hears you, and a church family who walks beside you. Those are blessings worth more than anything money can buy.

Gratitude shifts our focus. Instead of seeing only what's missing, it helps us notice what's been mercifully given. It's the difference between complaining about the rain and thanking God for watering the earth. It's choosing to see His fingerprints in the ordinary moments—a sunrise, a shared laugh, a quiet prayer answered in just the right way.

If your heart feels heavy this Thanksgiving, know this: God is still near.

The same God who provided manna in the wilderness and calmed the storm on the sea is still providing for you today. Sometimes His provision looks like strength to get through the day, peace that steadies a troubled heart, or people He places in your path to remind you that you're not alone.

Recently, in my devotional time, I read these words from Proverbs 4:23. "Guard your heart above all else, for it determines the course of your life."

I shared with my wife that God has honored the guarding of my heart simply by leading me to the places where I have lived, particularly here in Busti. God has filled my journey with beautiful people like you!

Sally then shared another verse with me from Psalm 16:6, which says, 'The land you have given me is a pleasant land. What a wonderful inheritance!"

Another reminder that when we honor God, he blesses us with an inheritance that includes so much more than monetary resources.

So as you gather around the table, before you lift your fork, take a moment to lift your heart. Thank Him for His mercy, His faithfulness, and His never-ending love. Let gratitude be more than a moment—it can be your mindset.

Because when our hearts are thankful, our lives become testimonies of God's grace. And that's something worth celebrating—not just at the end of November, but every day of the year.

From my heart to yours—Happy Thanksgiving! May you know the joy that comes from seeing God's hand in every season and trusting that His goodness never runs out.


