

To ensure the deductibility of your church contributions, please do not file your 2025 tax return until you have received a written acknowledgment of your contributions from the church. Some of your contributions may not be tax-deductible if you file your tax return before receiving a written acknowledgment of your contributions from the church.

December 31: Donors must *deliver or mail (and postmark)* checks on or by this date in order to claim a charitable contribution deduction for 2025. Checks that are placed in the church offering on the first Sunday in 2026 *will not qualify for a charitable contribution deduction in 2025*, even if the check is predated to 2025 or was actually written in 2025. However, checks that are written, mailed, and postmarked in 2025 will be deductible in 2025 though they are not received by the church until 2026.
