> **The Book of JOB Chapters 8 – 14 - “WHY NOT?”**

Chapter 8 - “Bildad's Opinion”

(v1-10) It's my opinion that your sons were sinning so God judged them (v4).

It's also my opinion that you need to earnestly seek God (v5).

It's also my opinion that if you were pure and upright that God would prosper you (v6).

(v11-18) It's also my opinion that you may have forgotten God and you may be a hypocrite (v13).

(v19-22) In my opinion if you do right, God will fix you. But if you keep doing wrong God will judge you.

Chapter 9 - “Job's Righteous Response”

(v1-13) Job declares the OMNIPOTENCE (all-powerful) of God!

(v14-20) Job proclaims his unrighteousness & affirms the righteousness of God!

(v21-31) Job evaluates his life and sovereignty of God.

(v32-35) Job desires a mediator for his plight.

(Jesus Christ our MEDIATOR- 1 Timothy 2:5-7- *For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus, who gave Himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time, Hebrews 4:14-16- Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need. Hebrews 2:18- For in that He Himself has suffered, being tempted, He is able to aid those who are tempted.)*

Chapter 10 - “Job's Contemplation”

(v1-12) Help me to understand.

(v13-17) Job considers “Murphy's Law”

(v18-22) Job's despair!

Chapter 11 - “Zophar Not So Good!”

(v1-6) Talk is cheap!

(v7-12) Job you don't know nothin!

(v13-20) Job you need to prepare your heart and turn from your wickedness!

(John Ch. 9- “Lord, why was this man born blind? Who sinned?”)

Chapter 12 - “Job's Rebuttal”

(v1-6) My friends mock me.

(v7-25) God is . . .

Chapter 13 - “Job's Rebuke!”

(v1-12) Who do you think you are?

(v13-19) Listen carefully!

- **I will trust God! (v15)**
- **God is my salvation! (v16)**
- **God is my vindication! (v18)**

(v20-28) Job prays.

Chapter 14 - “*Job Reasons with Life, Death & the Resurrection!*”

(v1-6) Birth—trouble—death.

(v7-12) Hope?

(v13-22) If a man dies shall he live again? (John Ch. 11:1-44)
