### CHATPER 26 – "NUMBERING THE NEW GENERATION"

(v1-56) Here we see the numbering of the new generation, those who will go into the "Promise Land."

(v57-62) This is the numbering of the Levites, although they are not numbered amongst the children of Israel. Unlike the other tribes of Israel, the Levites received no territorial inheritance in the promised land of Canaan. Their portion was to be God Himself (Numbers 18:20), who commanded that 48 cities be set apart for them, along with enough pasture for their cattle (Numbers 35:1-8). They were to receive the tithes due God from the fruits of the fields, the flocks and herds, the fruits of the firstborn, and certain portions of the people's sacrificial offerings (Numbers 18:24). Of these tithes, the Levites had to turn over a tithe (a tenth part) to the priests (Numbers 18:26).

(v63-65) There are only two from the old generation that will be able to go into the "Promise Land," these are Caleb and Joshua, men of FAITH! (Hebrews 11:6 - But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.)

#### CHAPTER 27 – "INHERITANCE & LEADERSHIP"

(v1-11) Moses is questioned about can an inheritance be given to daughters if there is no sons, as the father has died. Observe closely Moses response in verse 5, "So Moses brought their case before the LORD." Question, do you bring your case or others case before the LORD. We must realize that God wants to counsel us and help us; remember what Jesus said in Matthew 6:33 - But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you. (Read Psalm 119 to understand the wisdom and knowledge to be discovered in God's Word!)

(v12-14) Moses is to prepare for his death. (Factor in the faithful life of Moses according to Hebrews 11:23-29; we also see Moses on the Mt. of Transfiguration in Matthew Ch. 17:1-12.) (v15-23) Joshua is to succeed Moses. J. Oswald Sanders writes in his book Spiritual Leadership— "Effective spiritual leadership does not come as a result of theological training or seminary degree, as important as education is. Jesus told His disciples, "you did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you" (John 15:16). The sovereign selection of God gives great confidence to Christian

workers. We can truly say, "I am neither by selection of an individual nor election of a group, but by the almighty appointment of God."

John MacArthur in his book Rediscovering Pastoral Ministry gives insight to spiritual leadership as he asks the question, "What marks a man effective in the ministry?" (Five keys.)

- Key #1 - TENACITY - he trusts totally in God's power!

- Key #2 - INTEGRITY - his life is consistent with his doctrine!

- Key #3 - AUTHORITY - he receives his commission from God, not himself!

- Key #4 - ACCOUNTABILITY - he is constantly aware of the implications of God's omniscience!

- Key #5 - HUMILITY - he is consumed not with himself, but with the glory of God!
