## Chapter 3 - Job Declares: "I wish I'd never been born!"

(v1-10) Mayday! Mayday! Mayday! (A dozen times!) *Mayday* is an emergency code word used internationally as a distress signal in voice procedure radio communications. It derives from the French *venez m'aider*, meaning 'come help me'.<sup>[1]</sup> It is used to signal a life-threatening emergency by many groups, such as police forces, pilots, firefighters, and transportation organizations. The call is always given three times in a row ("Mayday - Mayday -Mayday") to prevent mistaking it for some similar-sounding phrase under noisy conditions, and to distinguish an actual Mayday call from a message about a Mayday call.

(v11-23) Why, why, why, why, why, why? (Approximately seven times!) (v24-26) Job's honesty- *"that which I feared and dreaded has happened to me"* 

## Chapter 4 & 5 - The Assumptions of Eliphaz

(4:1-6) Hey Job, you can dish it out, but you can take it!
(4:7-11) Hey Job, you brought this on, because you've been secretly sinning!
(4:12-21) Hey Job, I had a dream about you & it's a nightmare! (Christians Beware: Galatians 1:6-10; 1Timothy 4:1-5; 2 Corinthians 11:1-4)
(v5:1-7) Job accused of wrath, envy & foolishness
(v5:8-16) If I were you, I would seek God.
(v5:17-27) God must be chastening you.

### Chapter 6 - Job's Response – "I'm Bummed!"

(v1-13) Crush me God! (v14-30) "Hey Eliphaz, I need pity & comfort!"

### Chapter 7 - Job Declares A Reality Check

(v1-10) Let's get real with what I'm going through! (v11-16) Eliphaz, you scare me! (v17-21) Job turns to God & converses with Him!
