



**“The Remnant, The Davidic Kingdom,
God is My Salvation!”**
Isaiah Chapters 10—12

CHAPTER 10- “THE REMNANT!”

- (v1-4) This continues the theme of God’s judgment on the Northern Kingdom (Israel) which started in chapter 9 verse 8; whereas, *social evils* are decreed in chapter 10:1-5.
(v5-19) God’s uses Assyria to judge Israel, then He will bring judgment on Assyria.
(v20-27) Israel & Jacob - A Remnant Survives (Understand the “remnant” of Israel in the “last days” - Romans ch. 11).
(v28-34) God will judge and defeat the Assyrians.

CHAPTER 11- “DAVIDIC KINGDOM TO BE RESTORED!”

(v1-5) Christ to come & rule - *“a branch”* - This messianic usage apparently originated with the prophet Isaiah (4:2; 11:1). It reappeared in the prophecies of Jeremiah, where it referred to a future king in the line of David, whose coming would bring judgment and righteousness (Jer 23:5-6). After the Captivity, the term was a recognized title of the Messiah (Zech 3:8). (From Nelson’s Illustrated Bible Dictionary)

(v2) “Sevenfold work of the Spirit”:

- Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him (Luke 4:18-19)
 - 1- Spirit of Wisdom
 - 2- Spirit of Understanding
 - 3- Spirit of Counsel - Proverbs 1
 - 4- Spirit of Might
 - 5- Spirit of Knowledge
 - 6- Spirit of the fear of the LORD

(v4) “rod of His mouth” - Psalm 2; Revelation 19:15;

“breath of His lips” – 2 Thessalonians 2:8

(v6-9) Peace & Safety in the Millennial Kingdom.

(v10-16) Gentiles & Jews gathered into the Millennial Kingdom.

CHAPTER 12- “PRAISE THE LORD!”

(v1-3) Praise Him for SALVATION!

(v4-6) Praise Him for His GREATNESS!

- G.B. Williamson writes “God in the Midst”:
 - #1- God is great (v6), as Creator, Redeemer, and Conqueror;
 - #2- God in the midst of His people, (v6b), always and everywhere;
 - #3- Shout the greatness of God, (v4), who is our Strength, (v2); our salvation, (v2); and our Song, (v2, 5).
