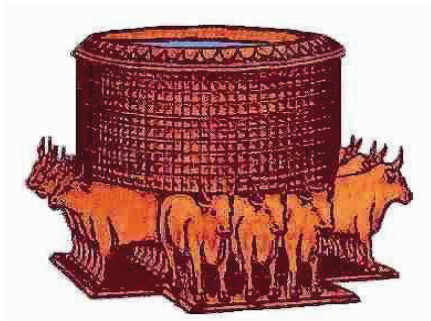
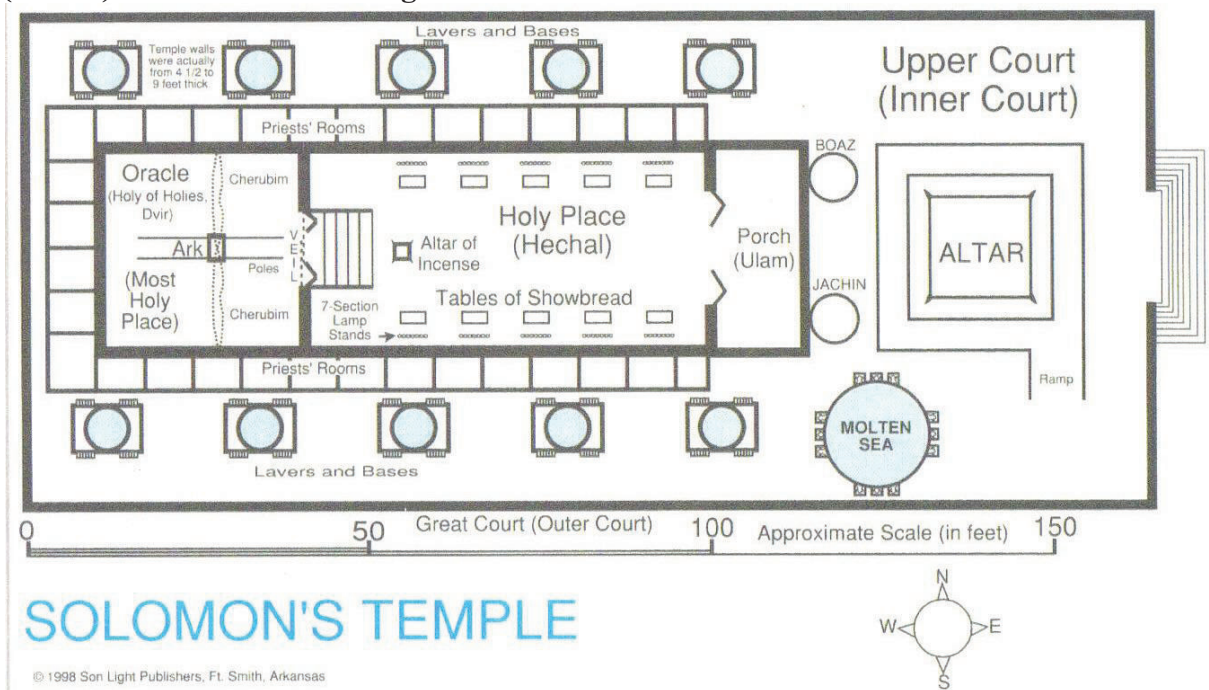
“The Glory of the LORD!”

(v1-12) Here is the making of Solomon’s palace.

(v13-47) Hiram was an artisan of Tyre, a skilled craftsmen who built various parts, items and furnishings of the Temple.

(v48-51) With these furnishings the house of the LORD was “FINISHED”.



CHAPTER 8 – FILLED WITH GLORY!

(v1-2) Solomon scheduled the dedication of the temple with the *Feast of Tabernacles* held in the seventh month. That was also a Jubilee year, so it was especially appropriate (Lev. 23:33–36, 39–43; Deut. 16:13–15).

(v3-11) The *Ark of the Covenant* is brought into the Temple, into the *Most Holy Place*. ***The CLOUD, the GLORY OF THE LORD FILLED THE HOUSE OF THE LORD!***
