<u>The Second Book of the KINGS</u> <u>Chapters 6 – 7</u> "<u>The Acts of Elisha!</u>"

> Remember: Elisha's name means "God is salvation."

Chapter 6- "The Acts of Elisha"

(v1-7) <u>A</u> – Elisha is a man of <u>ACTION</u> (Hopelessness is an opportunity for <u>helpfulness</u>!)

(v8-17) <u>C</u> – Elisha <u>CALLS</u> upon the LORD! (Romans 10:10-13 - For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For the Scripture says, "Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame." For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him. For "whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved.") (v18-23) <u>T</u> – Elisha is a <u>TEACHER</u> of God's grace and mercy! (Ephesians 2:8-9) (v24-33) <u>S</u> – Elisha's <u>SCHOOL</u> of knowledge.

Chapter 7- *"Elisha Proclaims The Word of LORD!"* (v1-11) From famine to feasting, HOW? Elisha said, *"HEAR THE WORD OF THE LORD!*"

(v9) The 4 lepers proclaimed the "<u>GOOD NEWS!</u>" Our *"good news"* is the gospel; the word "gospel" is found 100 times in the New Testament.

> <u>Observe five "gospel" lessons</u>:

(1) Jesus <u>preached</u> the gospel - Matthew 4:23-25; (2) the gospel will be preached to the <u>end of the age</u> - Matthew 24:3-14; (3) the gospel is <u>power</u> - Romans 1:16-17; (4) the gospel makes you <u>beautiful</u> – Romans 10:14-17; (5) the gospel will be preached in the "<u>great tribulation</u>" - Revelation 14:6-7.

(v12-20) God provides, but unbelief is a killer! (Rev. ch. 20)
