- b. How do these passages inform our understanding of who Jesus is, what he came to do, and what he will do in the future?
- c. What do you picture when you think of heaven? Does it look anything like this?
- d. What is significant about this "great multitude that no one could number, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb"?
- **5. Read Matthew 28:18–20.** How can you do to take the gospel to, pray for, and give to the reaching of the nations this week and for the rest of your life on this earth as you look forward to heaven?
