- **4. Read Ephesians 4:2-3**. Think through relationships, particularly with other Christians, in which you are struggling to get along. What evidence of pride, harshness, and impatience do you see in your heart?
- 5. Read Ephesians 4:4-6. How could these gospel truths help you be more humble, patient, and gentle?
- 6. What is a practical step you can take to "re-gospel" yourself this week?

QUESTIONS FOR KIDS

- 1. Read Ephesians 4:2-3. What do these verses tell us to do? Why?
- 2. What do you think people in the world think about Christians? What does Jesus want people in the world to think about His followers?
- 3. Even if we know that Jesus is our Savior and Lord, Pastor Ken is reminding us that we should "re-gospel". We should remember every day that God has saved us through Jesus. Do you think remembering that will help you get rid of impatience, harshness, and pride? Why?
