- 1. **Intro**: When was a time that you felt overlooked or excluded? In other words, when was a time that you were a victim of someone's favoritism? How did it make you feel?
- 2. Read James 2:1. What makes favoritism incompatible with faith in Jesus?
- 3. **Read James 2:2-4**. We show favoritism because we think we stand something to gain from it. How do you see this to be true in your own life?
- 4. **Read James 2:5**. What does God offer us that should set us free from the sin of favoritism and the desire for worldly power?
- 5. **Read James 2:6-11**. What makes putting our trust in worldly power so dangerous, and what makes the sin of favoritism so serious?
- 6. **Read James 2:6-11**. Mercy is the opposite of favoritism. What does that look like practically? To whom can you show mercy this week?

QUESTIONS FOR KIDS

- 1. **Read James 2:1**. James is telling us if we are believers in Jesus Christ, then we shouldn't show favoritism. Why?
- 2. **Read James 2:8**. James calls "loving our neighbor as ourselves" the royal law. Over and over in scripture we are told to love other people. Why?
- 3. What are some things that make us show favoritism towards people? Ask God for His help in seeing all His children the way He sees them.
