1. **Intro:** When is a time in your life when you didn't give something or someone a chance at first, only to find out later that there was more to that person or thing than you realized, and it or he/she was awesome?
2. **Read Revelation 1:1, 9-16.** Jesus is more *satisfying* than anything. What are ways that people try to satisfy the hunger of their souls with lesser things than Jesus?
3. **Read Revelation 1:17a.** Jesus is more *glorious* than anything. Our tendency is to take God's gifts and turn them into gods. But they always lose their luster or leave us wanting more. How does this play out in people's lives?
4. **Read Revelation 1:17b-18 & Colossians 1:15-17.** Jesus is more *necessary* than anything. How can one know if Jesus is the point of his/her life and not simply part of his/her life?
5. **Read Revelation 1:5, 13 & Daniel 7:13-14.** Jesus is more *worthy* than anything. Jesus is the King of kings and Lord of lords. What would a life fully surrendered to the lordship of Jesus look like?
6. How would your life look different this week if you truly embrace the truth that Jesus is more satisfying, glorious, necessary, and worthy than anything?

QUESTIONS FOR KIDS

1. Today we learned that Jesus is MORE. Jesus is always more than we can know or imagine. What does that mean?

Jesus is MORE satisfying, MORE glorious, MORE necessary, MORE worthy than anything we know or imagine. Talk about:

- How does Jesus satisfy? What does your soul long for?
- How is Jesus glorious?
- Why is Jesus necessary?
- What does it mean in your life that Jesus is worthy?
