QUESTIONS FOR KIDS

- 1. **Read James 1:2**. Everyone faces hard things. Does God let us face hard things to be mean? Why do you think God allows us to face hard things?
- 2. When you face hard things, is it easy to trust God? Do you talk to God about hard things you face?
