

1 Sacrificial Son

2 Genesis 22:1

- 22:1 And it came to be after these events that Elohim tried Abraham, and said to him, "Abraham!" And he said, "Here I am." 2 And He said, "Take your son, now, your only son Yitshaq, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriyah, and offer him there as an ascending offering on one of the mountains which I command you." 3 And Abraham rose early in the morning and saddled his donkey, and took two of his young men with him, and Yitshaq his son. And he split the wood for the ascending offering, and arose and went to the place which Elohim had commanded him. 4 And on the third day Abraham lifted his eyes and saw the place from a distance.

3 Faith Without Works

- 15 And the Messenger of יהוה called to Abraham a second time from the heavens, 16 and said, "By Myself I have sworn, declares יהוה, because you have done this, and have not withheld your son, your only son, 17 that I shall certainly bless you, and I shall certainly increase your seed as the stars of the heavens and as the sand which is on the seashore, and let your seed possess the gate of their enemies. 18 And in your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice

4 Faith & Works

- Romans 4:3 For what does the Scripture say? "Abraham believed Elohim, and it was reckoned to him for righteousness."
- James (Jacob) 2:8 Was not Abraham our father declared right by works when he offered Yitshaq his son on the slaughter-place? 22 Do you see that the belief was working with his works, and by the works the belief was perfected? 23 And the Scripture was filled which says, "Abraham believed Elohim, and it was reckoned to him for righteousness." And He called him, "he who loves Elohim."

5 Judaism...No Human Sacrifice

- Why did G-d need to "test" Abraham, given that He knows the human heart better than we know it ourselves? Maimonides answers that G-d did not need Abraham to prove his love for Him. Rather the test was meant to establish for all time how far the fear and love of G-d must go...

6 Psalm 49

- 7 A brother does not redeem anyone at all, Neither give to Elohim a ransom for him; 8 For the redemption of their lives is costly, And it shall cease forever; 9 That he should still live forever, And not see the pit. 10 For he sees wise men die, The foolish and the ignorant both perish, And shall leave their wealth to others. 11 Their inner thoughts are their houses, forever; Their dwelling places, to all generations; They call their lands after their own names. 12 But man does not remain in esteem, He is like the beasts that perish.

7 Mind Of Elohim...Types & Shadows

- Heaven & Earth are witnesses
- Adam (Eve)...Disobedience & Death
- Animal dies to provide coverings...Atonemet (Lamb-Ram?)

8 Correct & In-Correct Worship

- Gen 4:3 And it came to be, in the course of time, that Qayin brought an offering of the fruit of the ground to 4. יהוה And Heḇel also brought of the first-born of his flock and of their fat. And יהוה looked to Heḇel and his offering,⁵ but He did not look to Qayin and his offering. And Qayin was very wroth, and his face fell.

9 Atonement For The Nations (Beasts)

- Gen 6:18 "And I shall establish My covenant with you, and you shall come into the ark, you and your sons and your wife and your sons' wives with you.¹⁹ "And of all the living of all flesh, two of each, you are to bring into the ark, to keep them alive with you – a male and a female.²⁰ "Of the birds after their kind, and of the cattle after their kind, and of all creeping creatures of the ground after their kind, two of each are to come to you, to keep them alive

10 Beasts Are The Nations

- Acts 10:11 and he saw the heaven opened and a certain vessel like a great sheet bound at the four corners, descending to him and let down to the earth,¹² in which were all kinds of four-footed beasts of the earth, and wild beasts, and creeping creatures, and the birds of the heaven.¹³ And a voice came to him, "Rise up, Kēpha, slay and eat.
- ²⁸ And he said to them, "You know that a Yehudī man is not allowed to associate with, or go to one of another race. But Elohim has shown me that I should not call any man (nations) common or unclean.

11 Isaac & Ram

- Gen 22:8 And Aḇraham said, "My son, Elohim does provide for Himself the lamb for an ascending offering." And the two of them went together.
- ¹³ And Aḇraham lifted his eyes and looked and saw behind him a ram caught in a bush by its horns, and Aḇraham went and took the ram and offered it up for an ascending offering instead of his son.

12 Sheep-Rams-Beasts...People

- Ps 80:1 Give ear, O Shepherd of Yisra'ēl, Who leads Yosēph like a flock (Sheep-Goats); Who dwells between the keruḇim, shine forth!
- Ez 34:6 My sheep (People) wandered through all the mountains, and on every high hill. And My sheep were scattered over all the face of the earth, and no one was seeking or searching for them."^{....12} "As a shepherd seeks out his flock on the day he is among his scattered sheep (People), so I shall seek out My sheep (Peopel) and deliver them from all the places where they were scattered in a day of cloud and thick darkness... ¹⁷ And as for you, O My flock, thus said the Master יהוה, "See, I am judging between sheep and sheep, between rams and goats (People).

13 Yeshua Keeps the Type...

- Matt 25:31 "And when the Son of Aḁam comes in His esteem, and all the set-apart messengers with Him, then He shall sit on the throne of His esteem.³² "And all the nations shall be gathered before Him, and He shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd separates his sheep from the goats.

- Luke 15:4 "What man among you, having a hundred sheep, and having lost one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the wilderness and go after the one which is lost until he finds it? 5 "And having found it, he lays it on his shoulders, rejoicing. 6 "And having come home, he calls together his friends and neighbours, saying to them, 'Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep which was lost!' 7 "I say to you that in the same way there shall be more joy in the heaven over one sinner repenting, than over ninety-nine righteous ones who need no repentance

14 **Human (Sheep) Sacrifice**

- Isaiah 53:6 We all, like sheep, went astray, each one of us has turned to his own way. And יהוה has laid on Him (Man) the crookedness of us all. 7 He was oppressed and He was afflicted, but He did not open His mouth. He (Man) was led as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before its shearers is silent, but He did not open His mouth.
- Matt 27:13 Then Pilate said to Him, "Do You not hear how much they witness against You?" 14 And He (Yeshua-Passover Lamb) did not answer him, not one word, so that the governor wondered much

15 **Rev 5**

- Rev 5:2 And I saw in the right hand of Him who sat on the throne a scroll (heavenly) written inside and on the back, having been sealed with seven seals. 2 And I saw a strong messenger proclaiming with a loud voice, "Who is worthy (MAN) to open the scroll and to loosen its seals?" 3 And no one (MAN) in the heaven (24 Elders) or on the earth (Living) or under the earth (Grave) was able to open the scroll, or to look at it. 4 And I wept much, because no one (MAN) was found worthy to open and read the scroll, or to look at it. 5 And one of the elders said to me, "Do not weep. See, the Lion of the tribe of Yehudah, the Root of Dawid, overcame to open the scroll and to loosen its seven seals." 6 And I looked and saw in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders a Lamb (MAN-Yeshua) standing, as having been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of Elohim sent out into all the earth.

- John 15:13 "No one has greater love than this: that one should lay down his life for his friends. 14 "You are My friends if you do whatever I command you
