- 1And Abraham was old, advanced in years. And יהוה had blessed Abraham in every way.2And Abraham said to the oldest servant of his house, who ruled over all that he had, "Please, put your hand under my thigh,3so that I make you swear by יהוה, the Elohim of the heavens (Scroll-Witness) and the Elohim of the earth (Witness), that you do not take a wife for my son from the daughters of the Kena'anites, among whom I dwell,4but to go to my land and to my relatives, and take a wife for my son Yitshaq."

- Eternal Covenant Meal (Bread-Wine) King Priest Melchizedek
- Promised a Son and Lineage
- Told to read the Heavenly Scroll...SEED
- Failed at earning what could only be given, (Ishmael)
- Receives a Son (Isaac)-Promise
- Gives His Son as a offering...Resurrection

4 Genesis 24:1-4

- 1And Abraham was old, advanced in years. 5 A Wedding Feast

- Matt 22:1And יהושע responded and spoke to them again by parables and said,2"The reign of the heavens is like a man, a sovereign, who made a wedding feast for his son,3and sent out his servants to call those who were invited to the wedding feast. But they would not come.4Again he sent out other servants, saying, 'Say to those who are invited, "See, I have prepared my dinner. My oxen and fattened cattle are slaughtered, and all is ready. Come to the wedding feast."' 5"But they disregarded it and went their way – this one to his field, that one to his trade.6"And the rest, having seized his servants, insulted and killed them.

6 Same Story....

- Matt 22:1And יהושע responded and spoke to them again by parables and said,2"The reign of the heavens is like a man, a sovereign, who made a wedding feast for his son,3and sent out his servants (Heavenly Scroll-Mazereth-Earth) to call those who were invited to the wedding feast

7 Very Important Constellations

- The Hunter Saves and takes a bride...

8 Orion (strong-man) Andromeda, Cassiopeia

- Psalm 19:5 And it is like a bridegroom (Son) coming out of his room, It rejoices like a strong man to run the path

9 **Bride Out Of Babylon**

- Eldest Servant "Eliezer": H461... Yah's help, God of Help
- So some time after the offering of the Son (Death), provision of a ram, resurrection of Isaac, confirmation of the Covenant, Abraham sends Eliezar-God's Help, to prepare a bride on behalf of His Son!
- John 14:15 "If you love Me, you shall guard My commands.16" And I shall ask the Father, and He shall give you another Helper, to stay with you forever –17 the Spirit of the Truth, whom the world is unable to receive, because it does not see Him or know Him. But you know Him, for He stays with you and shall be in you.

10 **Helper Is Poured Out**

- John 7:37 And on the last day, the great day of the festival, יהושע stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me, and let him who believes in Me drink.38" As the Scripture said, out of His innermost shall flow rivers of living water."39 And this He said concerning the Spirit, which those believing in Him were about to receive, for the Set-apart Spirit was not yet given, because יהושע was not yet esteemed.40 Many from the crowd, when they heard the word, then said, "This truly is the Prophet."41 Others said, "This is the Messiah," but others said, "Does the Messiah then come out of Galil?"

11 **Rebekah By A Well...**

- Gen 24:10-14 10 And the servant took ten of his master's camels and left, for all his master's good gifts were in his hand. And he arose and went to Aram Naharayim, to the city of Naḥor.11 And he made his camels kneel down outside the city by a fountain of water at evening time, the time when women go out to draw water.12 And he said, "יהוה, Elohim of my master Abraham, please cause her to meet before me this day, and show loving-commitment to my master Abraham.13" See, I am standing here by the fountain of water, and the daughters of the men of the city are coming out to draw water14 "Now let it be that the young woman to whom I say, 'Please let down your jar to let me drink,' and she says, 'Drink, and let me water your camels too,' let her be the one whom You have appointed for Your servant Yitshaq. And let me know by this that You have shown loving-commitment to my master."

12 **Being On The "WAY"**

- Gen 24:18 And she said, "Drink, my master." And she hurried and let her jar down to her hand, and gave him a drink.19 And when she had finished giving him a drink, she said, "Let me draw water for your camels too, until they have finished drinking."... .26 And the man bowed down his head and worshipped 27. יהוה And he said, "Blessed be יהוה Elohim of my master Abraham, who has not forsaken His loving-commitment and His truth toward my master. As for me, being on the way, יהוה led me to the house of my master's brothers."

13 **John 4...Woman at the well**

- Jn 4:7A woman of Shomeron came to draw water. יהושע said to her, "Give Me to drink. ... יהושע answered and said to her, "If you knew the gift of Elohim, and who it is who says to you, 'Give Me to drink,' you would have asked Him, and He would have given you living water."... 25The woman said to Him, "I know that Messiah is coming, the One who is called Anointed. When that One comes, He shall announce to us all."26יהושע said to her, "I who am speaking to you am He."

14 Heart Was In Babylon

- John 4:15 The woman said to Him, "Master, give me this water, so that I do not thirst, nor come here to draw."16יהושע said to her, "Go, call your husband, and come here."17The woman answered and said, "I have no husband." יהושע said to her, "You have well said, 'I have no husband,'18for you have had five husbands, and the one whom you now have is not your husband. What you have said is true."
- (6 Husbands) Egypt, Assyria, Babylon, Medo-Persia, Greece....Rome (Babel)

15 A Wife Out Of Babylon

- Rev 18:3And he cried with a mighty voice, saying, "Babel the great is fallen, is fallen, and has become a dwelling place of demons, a haunt for every unclean spirit, and a haunt for every unclean and hated bird,3because all the nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her whoring, and the sovereigns of the earth have committed whoring with her, and the merchants of the earth have become rich through the power of her riotous living."4And I heard another voice from the heaven saying,(Eliezer-Spirit) "Come out of her, my people, lest you share in her sins, and lest you receive of her
