- 4:6And יהוה said to Qayin, "Why is he wroth towards you? And why is your face fallen? 7Is it not if you do good, you are to be accepted? And if you do not do good, towards the door is a sin. He is lying and towards you is his desire, and you must rule over him."8And Qayin told Hebel his brother. And it came to be when they were in the field, that Qayin rose up against Hebel his brother and killed him.

7 Two Natures

• Romans 7:For we know that the Torah is Spiritual, but I am fleshly, sold under sin.15For what I work, I know not. For what I wish, that I do not practise, but what I hate, that I do.16But if I do what I do not wish, I agree with the Torah that it is good.17And now, it is no longer I that work it, but the sin dwelling in me.18For I know that in me, that is in my flesh, dwells no good. For to wish is present with me, but to work the good I do not find.19For the good that I wish to do, I do not do; but the evil I do not wish to do, this I practise.20And if I do that which I do not wish, it is no longer I who work it, but the sin dwelling in me.21I find therefore this law, that when I wish to do the good, that the evil is present with me.22For I delight in the Torah of Elohim according to the inward man,23but I see another torah in my members, battling against the torah of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the torah of sin which is in my members.24Wretched man that I am! Who shall deliver me from this body of death?

8 Importance of Abel

• Matt 23:29"Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees (CAIN), hypocrites! Because you build the tombs of the prophets (ABEL) and decorate the monuments of the righteous,30and say, 'If we had lived in the days of our fathers, we would not have taken part with them in the blood (MURDER) of the prophets.'31Thus you bear witness against yourselves that you are sons of those who did murder the prophets –32and you (CAIN) fill up the measure of your fathers!33"Serpents (SEED), brood of adders! How would you escape the judgment of GĕHinnom (Fire)?34"Because of this, see, I send you prophets, and wise men, and scholars of Scripture (Abels). Some of them you shall kill and impale, and some of them you shall flog in your congregations and persecute from city to city,35so that on you should come all the righteous blood shed on the earth, from the blood of righteous Hebel to the blood of Zekaryah (John's Father), son of Berekyah, whom you murdered between the Dwelling Place and the slaughter-place.

9 By Faith ... Abel

• Hebrews 11:1IB`RIM (HEBREWS) 1And belief is the substance of what is expected, the proof of what is not seen.2For by this the elders obtained witness.3By belief, we understand that the ages were prepared by the word of Elohim, so that what is seen was not made of what is visible.4By belief, Hebel offered to Elohim a greater slaughter offering than Qayin, through which he obtained witness that he was righteous, Elohim witnessing of his gifts. And through it, having died, he still speaks.5By belief, Ḥanok was translated so as not to see death, "and was not found because Elohim had translated him." For before his translation he obtained witness, that he pleased Elohim.6But without belief it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to Elohim has to believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who earnestly seek Him.
