2 Covenant Promise

- Gen 12:1-3 And יהוה said to Abram, "Go yourself out of your land, from your relatives and from your father's house, to a land which I show you.2" And I shall make you a great nation, and bless you and make your name great, and you shall be a blessing!3" And I shall bless those who bless you, and curse him who curses you. And in you all the clans of the earth shall be blessed."

3 Babel to Abraham...Stars

- Yahser 8:9 We (wise men-astrologers) heard that a son was born to Terah the son of Nahor, the prince of thy host, and we yesternight came to his house, and we ate and drank and rejoiced with him that night.10 And when thy servants went out from the house of Terah, to go to our respective homes to abide there for the night, we lifted up our eyes to heaven, and we saw a great star coming from the east, and the same star ran with great speed, and swallowed up four great stars, from the four sides of the heavens.11 And thy servants were astonished at the sight which we saw, and were greatly terrified, and we made our judgment upon the sight, and knew by our wisdom the proper interpretation thereof, that this thing applies to the child that is born to Terah, who will grow up and multiply greatly, and become powerful, and kill all the kings of the earth, and inherit all their lands, he and his seed forever.12 And now our lord and king, behold we have truly acquainted thee with what we have seen concerning this child.13 If it seemeth good to the king to give his father value for this child, we will slay him before he shall grow up and increase in the land, and his evil increase against us, that we and our children perish through his evil.14 And the king heard their words and they seemed good in his sight, and he sent and called for Terah, and Terah came before the king.15 And the king said to Terah, I have been told that a son was yesternight born to thee, and after this manner was observed in the heavens at his birth.16 And now therefore give me the child, that we may slay him before his evil springs up against us, and I will give thee for his value, thy house full of silver and gold.17 And Terah answered the king and said to him: My Lord and king, I have heard thy words, and thy servant shall do all that his king desireth.

4 Star In The East

- Matt 2:1 And יהושע having been born in Běyth Leḥem of Yehuḏah in the days of Herodes the sovereign, see, Magi from the east came to Yerushalayim,2 saying, "Where is He who has been born Sovereign of the Yehuḏim? For we saw His star in the East and have come to do reverence to Him."3 And Herodes the sovereign, having heard, was troubled, and all Yerushalayim with him.4 And having gathered all the chief priests and scribes of the people together, he asked them where the Messiah was to be born.5 And they said to him, "In Běyth Leḥem of Yehuḏah, for thus it has been written by the prophet,6" But you, Běyth Leḥem, in the land of Yehuḏah, you are by no means least among the rulers of Yehuḏah, for out of you shall come a Ruler who shall shepherd My people Yisra'ël. (Micah 5:2)

- 35And Terah took Abram his son secretly, together with his mother and nurse, and he concealed them in a cave, and he brought them their provisions monthly. 36 And the Lord was with Abram in the cave and he grew up, and Abram was in the cave ten years, and the king and his princes, soothsayers and sages, thought that the king had killed Abram.
- 9:5And when Abram came out from the cave, he went to Noah and his son Shem, and he remained with them to learn the instruction of the Lord and his ways, and no man knew where Abram was, and Abram served Noah and Shem his son for a long time.6 And Abram was in Noah's house thirty-nine years, and Abram knew the Lord from three years old, and he went in the ways of the Lord until the day of his death, as Noah and his son Shem had taught him; and all the sons of the earth (Babel-Babylon)in those days greatly transgressed against the Lord, and they rebelled against him and they served other gods, and they forgot the Lord who had created them in the earth; and the inhabitants of the earth made unto themselves, at that time, every man his god; gods of wood and stone which could neither speak, hear, nor deliver, and the sons of men served them and they became their gods

6 The Other Story....Babylon

- Gen 11:2And it came to be, as they set out from the east, that they found a plain in the land of Shin'ar, and they dwelt there.... 9That is why its name was called Babel, because there יהוה confused the language of all the earth, and from there יהוה scattered them over the face of all the earth.
- Dan 1:2And יהוה gave Yehoyaqim sovereign of Yehudah into his hand, with some of the utensils of the House of Elohim, which he brought to the land of Shin'ar to the house of his mighty one.
- 3:1Nebukadnetzar the sovereign made an image of gold, whose height was sixty cubits and its width six cubits. He set it up in the plain of Dura, in the province of Babel.
- Rev 18:2And he cried with a mighty voice, saying, "Babel the great is fallen, is fallen, and has become a dwelling place of demons, a haunt for every unclean spirit, and a haunt for every unclean and hated bird,

7 **Dan 4:20**"The tree you saw, which became great and strong, whose height reached to the heavens and was visible to all the earth,21whose leaves were lovely and its fruit plenty, and in it was food for all, under which the beasts of the field dwelt, and on whose branches the birds of the heavens sat –22it is you, O sovereign (Babylon-Beast), for you have become great and strong. And your greatness has grown, and has reached to the heavens and your rulership to the end of the earth.

8 Images Of The Same Thing...Babylon

- Rev 13:11And I saw another beast coming up out of the earth, and he had two horns like a lamb and spoke like a dragon.12And he exercises all the authority of the first beast in his presence, and causes the earth and those who dwell in it to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed.

9 This Will Happen Too!

- Rev 18:2And he cried with a mighty voice, saying, "Babel the great is fallen, is fallen,... 10 standing at a distance for fear of her torture, saying, 'Woe! Woe, the great city Babel, the mighty city, because your judgment has come in one hour!'

10 Abraham...Preacher

- Gen 12:4 So Abram left, as יהוה had commanded him, and Lot went with him. And Abram was seventy-five years old when he set out from Haran. 5 And Abram took Sarai his wife and Lot his brother's (Haran) son, and all their possessions that they had gathered, and the beings whom they had acquired in Haran, and they set out for the land of Kena'an. And they came to the land of Kena'an. 6 And Abram passed through the land to the place of Shekem, as far as the terebinth tree of Moreh. At that time the Kena'anites were in the land. 7 And יהוה appeared to Abram and said, "To your seed I give this land." And he built there a slaughter-place to יהוה, who had appeared to him. 8 And from there he moved to the mountain east of Bēyth Ĕl, and he pitched his tent, with Bēyth Ĕl on the west and Ai on the east. And he built there a slaughter-place to יהוה, and called (H 7121 qara: to preach) on the Name of יהוה.

11 Melchizedek...Salem

- Gen 14:18-20 And Malkitsedeq sovereign of Shalēm brought out bread and wine. (Covenant Meal) Now he was the priest of the Most High Ĕl. 19 And he blessed him and said, "Blessed be Abram of the Most High Ĕl, Possessor of the heavens and earth. 20" And blessed be the Most High Ĕl who has delivered your enemies into your hand. And he gave him a tenth of all.
- Heb 7:1 For this Malkitsedeq, sovereign of Shalēm, priest of the Most High Elohim, who met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the sovereigns and blessed him, 2 to whom also Abraham gave a tenth part of all, his name being translated, indeed, first, 'sovereign of righteousness,' and then also sovereign of Shalēm, that is, 'sovereign of peace,' 3 without father, without mother, without genealogy, having neither beginning of days nor end of life, but having been made like the Son of Elohim, remains a priest for all time.

12 Bread & Wine....Shabbat

- Melchizedek... 19 And he blessed him and said, "Blessed be Abram of the Most High Ĕl, Possessor of the heavens and earth. 20" And blessed be the Most High.
- Abraham-Isaac-Jacob...Israel...Shabbat Baruch ata YHVH, eloheinu melek ha olam, ha motzi lechem min ha aretz (blessed are you YHVH King of the universe who brings forth bread from the earth.)
- Baruch ata YHVH, eloheinu melek ha olam, boray prei ha gaffen ... (blessed are you YHVH, king of the universe, creator of the fruit of the vine.)
- Bread & Wine...Initiation of the Eternal Covenant

13 Eternal Covenant Meal...Bread-Wine

- Luke 22:15 And He said to them, "With desire I have desired to eat this Pěsaḥ with you before My suffering, 16 for I say to you, I shall certainly not eat of it again until it is filled in the reign of Elohim." 17 And taking the cup, giving thanks, He said, "Take this and divide it among yourselves, 18 for I say to you, I shall certainly not drink of the fruit of the vine until the reign of Elohim comes." 19 And taking bread, giving thanks, He broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is My body which is given for you, do this in remembrance of Me." 20 Likewise the cup also, after supper, saying, "This cup is the renewed covenant in My blood which is shed for you. (Explaining Melchizedek's Prayer)

14 **Yeshua Dies On Passover...Nissan (aviv) 14**

- 1 Cor 5:6 Your boasting is not good. Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the entire lump? 7 Therefore cleanse out the old leaven, so that you are a new lump, as you are unleavened. For also Messiah our Pěsaḥ was slaughtered for us. 8 So then let us celebrate the festival, not with old leaven, nor with the leaven of evil and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.

15 **Lord's Supper (Passover...?)**

- 1 Cor 11:17-22 And in declaring this I do not praise you, since you come together not for the better but for the worse. 18 For in the first place, I hear that when you come together as an assembly (Shabbat or Passover), there are divisions among you, and to some extent I believe it. 19 For there have to be factions even among you, so that the approved ones might be revealed among you. 20 So when you come together in one place (Shabbat or Passover), it is not to eat the Master's supper. (YHVH Passover?) 21 For, when you eat, each one takes his own supper first, and one is hungry and another is drunk. 22 Have you not houses to eat and drink in? Or do you despise the assembly of Elohim and shame those who have not? What shall I say to you? Shall I praise you in this? I do not praise!

16 **Lord's Supper (master's Supper)**

- 1 Cor 11:23 For I received from the Master that which I also delivered to you: that the Master יהושע in the night in which He was delivered (Passover) up took bread, 24 and having given thanks, He broke it and said, "Take, eat, this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me." 25 In the same way also the cup, after supper, saying, "This cup is the renewed covenant in My blood. As often (Once a year?...Shabbat) as you drink it, do this in remembrance of Me." (Explanation of Melchizedek's Prayer) 26 For as often (Passover - Shabbat) as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the death of the Master until He comes. (Melchizedek did... Before Eternal Covenant Sacrifice)

17 **Shabbat or Passover?**

- 1 Cor 11:27 So that whoever should eat this bread or drink this cup of the Master unworthily shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Master. 28 But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread and drink of that cup. 29 For the one who is eating and drinking unworthily, eats and drinks judgment to himself, not discerning the body of the Master. 30 Because of this many are weak and sick among you, and many sleep. 31 For if we were to examine ourselves, we would not be judged. 32 But when we are judged, we are disciplined by the Master, that we should not be condemned with the world. 33 So then, my brothers, when you come together to eat, (Bread-Wine) wait for one another (Shabbat?). 34 And if anyone is hungry, let him eat at home (Passover?), lest you come together for judgment. And the rest I shall set in order when I come.

18 **Passover Prohibition...Circumcision**

- Exodus 12:43 And יהוה said to Mosheh and Aharon, "This is the law of the Pěsaḥ: No son of a stranger is to eat of it,44 but any servant a man has bought for silver, when you have circumcised him, then let him eat of it.45 "A sojourner and a hired servant does not eat of it.46 "It is eaten in one house, you are not to take any of the flesh outside the house, nor are you to break any bone of it.47 "All the congregation of Yisra'ěl are to perform it.48 "And when a stranger sojourns with you and shall perform the Pěsaḥ to יהוה, let all his males be circumcised, and then let him come near and perform it, and he shall be as a native of the land. But let no uncircumcised eat of it.49 There is one Torah for the native-born and for the stranger who sojourns among you.

19 **Is Either.....**

- Ceremonial Meal Before Passover...Master's Supper
 - Whenever you eat of it.... Shabbat...Day before Passover
- Passover...YHVH Passover
 - Whenever you eat of it...Passover

20 **It's NOT Communion-Eucharist**

- Origins of Eucharist-Communion...Justin Taylor ... Historically, the Eucharist (Greek word "eucharistia/εὐχαριστία) meaning thanksgiving) and Sacrifice of a God man, were well known and well loved by Pagan mystery cults centuries before the Christian Cults integrated them into the Gospels... The Eucharist goes way back into history and is based upon the ritual consumption of the God man. Osiris, Dionysus, Attis and many others were ritually consumed.
