

THE LAW OF SOWING AND REAPING

Galatians 6:7–9

If you can embrace the lesson, three things will happen.

- 1. Clarity to your suffering
- 2. Peace to your confusion
- 3. Revelation to the season we are walking in.
- **The choice and the action make a difference.**
- **Deuteronomy 30:19**
- This day I call the heavens and the earth as witnesses against you that I have set before you life and death, blessings and curses. Now choose life, so that you and your children may live

- **Joshua 1:8**

- This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.

- **The blessing requires something**

- Prayer without knowledge is vain

- Prayer without alignment is fruitless

- Alignment without obedience is an illusion.

- Obedience without consistency wasted time

- The law of sowing and reaping is one of the most consistent spiritual principles in Scripture.
- It's simple, but it's not shallow.
- When you embrace it well, it becomes transformational because it touches every part of life:
 - Faith
 - Relationships
 - Finances
 - Character
 - Destiny.

Galatians 6:7–9

“Do not be deceived: God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap.”

Luke 6:38

Give, and it will be given to you.

A good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over, will be poured into your lap.

For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.”

Our harvest is never a surprise to God—it’s a reflection of your seed

The seed you sow determines the season you step into.

YOU REAP WHAT YOU SOW

- This is the principle of identity.
- Apple seeds produce apples.
- Kindness produces kindness.
- Sin produces destruction.
- Faith produces faithfulness.
- “If you don’t like what you’re reaping, check what you’re sowing.”

• **The Seed Determines the Harvest**

- You reap what you sow

Genesis 1:11

- And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, and the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed is in itself, upon the earth: and it was so.

God built the world so that seeds reproduce after their own kind.

You can't plant anger and expect peace.

You can't plant disobedience and expect blessing.

You can't plant nothing and expect something.

The Harvest Comes in Its Time

- You reap after you sow
- **Ecclesiastes 3:1–2**

To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven:

A time to be born, and a time to die; a time to plant, and a time to pluck up that which is planted;

Luke 5:5-6

And Simon answering said unto him, Master, we have toiled all the night, and have taken nothing: nevertheless at thy word I will let down the net.

And when they had this done, they enclosed a great multitude of fishes: and their net brake.

• **YOU REAP AFTER YOU SOW**

- This is the principle of timing.
- Seeds don't sprout overnight.
- Spiritual growth takes time.
- Harvest requires patience and consistency.
- This is why Paul says, "Do not grow weary in well-doing."
- The enemy's greatest attack is discouragement during the delay.
- **"Delay is not denial; it's development."**

Hebrews 10:36

- For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.
- **Habakkuk 2:3**
- For still the vision awaits its appointed time; it hastens to the end—it will not lie.
- If it seems slow, wait for it; it will surely come; it will not delay.
- **Many are afraid to sow for fear of loss.**
- When do we trust his word?

- **Isaiah 40:31**

- But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.

- **Psalm 27:14**

- “Wait on the LORD: Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: Wait, I say, on the LORD”

- **Psalm 25:3**

- Those who wait on the Lord can fully expect Him to fulfill their hope: “Indeed, none who wait for you shall be put to shame” (ESV).

• **YOU REAP MORE THAN YOU SOW**

- This is the principle of multiplication.
- One seed produces a tree.
- One act of obedience produces a lifetime of blessing.
- One moment of generosity produces a multiplied harvest.
- **This works both ways—good and bad.**
- A small compromise can grow into a stronghold.
- A small step of faith can open a door you never imagined.
- **“A seed looks small until it becomes a harvest.”**

- **The Harvest Is Always Greater**
- You reap more than you sow
- **Mark 4:8**
- And other fell on good ground, and did yield fruit that sprang up and increased; and brought forth, some thirty, and some sixty, and some an hundred.
- **Mark 10:30**
- But he shall receive an hundredfold now in this time, houses, and brethren, and sisters, and mothers, and children, and lands, with persecutions; and in the world to come eternal life.

Malachi 3:10

"Bring the full tithe into the storehouse, so that there may be food in My house.

Test Me in this, says the LORD of Hosts.

See if I will not open the windows of heaven and pour out for you blessing without measure."

The Guarantee

Genesis 8:22

"As long as the earth endures, seedtime and harvest, Cold and heat, summer and winter, day and night will never cease."

Malachi 3:6-9

6 For I am the Lord, I change not; therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed.

7 Even from the days of your fathers ye are gone away from mine ordinances, and have not kept them. Return unto me, and I will return unto you, saith the Lord of hosts. But ye said, Wherein shall we return?

8 Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings.

9 Ye are cursed with a curse: for ye have robbed me, even this whole nation.

Malachi 3:10-11

10 Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the Lord of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.

11 And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the Lord of hosts.

12 And all nations shall call you blessed: for ye shall be a delightsome land, saith the Lord of hosts.

HOW TO APPLY THE LAW IN 2026

Sow intentionally.

People don't drift into spiritual maturity.

Choose their seeds—habits, words, relationships, priorities.

Sow spiritually

Galatians 6 contrasts sowing to the flesh vs. sowing to the Spirit.

Invest in prayer, Scripture, worship, and obedience.

“Don't stop sowing. Don't stop believing. Don't stop doing good. Your harvest is already scheduled.”

HOW TO APPLY THE LAW IN 2026

Sow generously

Not just money—encouragement, forgiveness, service, compassion.

Generosity is a seed that always multiplies.

Sow consistently

The harvest belongs to God, but the sowing belongs to us.

Consistency beats intensity.

- **Kingdom Experience**
- **Laws of the bible**
- **The law of sowing and reaping**
- everything you do returns to you in a multiplied form
- **The law of hidden preparation**
- God always prepares people in secret before revealing them publicly
- **The law of divine timing**
- nothing happens early or late with God; delays our strategy, not accidental

- **Kingdom Experience**
- **Laws of the bible**
- **The law of exposure:**
- anything done in darkness eventually comes to light
- **Law logic**
- The last becoming first, the weak becoming strong,
- **The law of spiritual hunger,**
- The more you see God, the more he reveals
- **The law of alignment**
- When your life aligns with God's will, doors open without effort.

- **Position yourself to be blessed**
