Faith is not one-dimensional; it grows in seven distinct movements that shape a believer's walk with God.

- **Levels of Faith**

- **Luke 17:5**

- And the apostles said unto the Lord, Increase our faith.

- Faith moves on levels- How do we increase our faith?

- **Romans 10:17**

- So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

- **Get understanding**

Faith unto Salvation

Everyone is given the faith to be born again

Ephesians 2:8

For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:

Ephesians 6:16

“Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.”

The shield of faith is what will get us from level to level.

Romans 12:3

“For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.”

Everyone has a starting point, but you must advance.

Faith is to be used in God.

Mark 11:24 Have faith in God

Faith that Works

This branch shows how faith grows, moves, and produces fruit in the life of a believer.

Faith That Hears

Romans 10:17

Faith begins with hearing—not just sound, but spiritual receptivity.

Hearing means to understand with clarity

Faith that Works

This branch is about attentiveness.

God speaks through His Word, His Spirit, and His messengers.

Without hearing, nothing else in faith can grow.

Matthew 11:15

He who has ears to hear, let him hear!

Many believers struggle not because they lack faith, but because they lack hearing.

Ezekiel 3:27

But when I speak with you, I will open your mouth, and you are to tell them, ‘This is what the Lord GOD says.’ Whoever listens, let him listen; and whoever refuses, let him refuse, for they are a rebellious house.

Jeremiah 5:21

“Hear this, O foolish and senseless people, who have eyes but do not see, who have ears but do not hear.

Hear this

Daniel 7:25

And he shall speak great words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws: and they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of time.

Revelation 21:7

He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son.

This is where you work your faith

Luke 10:19

Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Jeremiah 33:3

Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and show thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not.

Acts 1:8

But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

John 7:38

He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.

Faith That Believes

Hebrews 11:6

This is the internal conviction that God is and that He rewards.

Belief is the root system of faith.

It anchors identity, hope, and trust.

It is the branch that stabilizes the soul in storms.

Belief is not emotion—it is alignment with God's truth.

Romans 4:21

“And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.”

Isaiah 41:10

So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed,
for I am your God.

I will strengthen you and help you.

I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.

Faith That Obeys

James 2:17

Obedience is faith made visible.

This branch produces action.

It turns revelation into movement.

It is the difference between faith talked about and faith lived out.

Obedience is not just perfection; it is direction.

Faith That Endures

Hebrews 10:36

For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.

Faith is about perseverance under pressure.

Endurance proves faith's authenticity.

It can not be counterfeit in trials, delays, and disappointments.

It keeps believers from quitting too soon.

Many lose blessings not because of disobedience but because of discouragement.

Matthew 24:13

When Jesus says, “The one who endures to the end will be saved”

He is speaking of those who are truly born again, whose lives are transformed by the power of the Holy Spirit.

True followers of Jesus Christ will withstand the onslaught of wickedness, recognize and reject false teaching, and cling fast to the truth of God’s Word.

Faith That Speaks

Mark 11:23

Faith has a voice.

Faith declares God's promises.

Faith confronts mountains.

Faith aligns the tongue with truth.

“What words have you been speaking that need to shift?”

Does your faith tell you to speak?

Faith That Gives

2 Corinthians 9:7–8

But this I say, He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully.

Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.

And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work:

Faith That Gives

Giving is a spiritual expression of trust.

Giving breaks the fear of lack.

Giving reveals who your source truly is.

Malachi 3:10

Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, **and prove me now herewith**, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.

Malachi 3:11-12

And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the LORD of hosts.

And all nations shall call you blessed: for ye shall be a delightsome land, saith the LORD of hosts.

Genesis 14:18-20

Then Melchizedek, king of Salem, brought out bread and wine since he was the priest of God Most High and he blessed Abram and said: “Blessed be Abram by God Most High, Creator of heaven and earth, and blessed be God Most High, who has delivered your enemies into your hand.”
