Main Point: God hates human pride, and graciously wants to dislodge us from every form of the false security it produces - from worldly comfort to wordly control

<u>Materialism</u> - a preoccupation with material objects, comforts and cares to the neglectful disinterest in or rejection of spiritual, intellectual, or cultural values.

<u>Pride</u> - a swelling of yourself: an overestimation of you and an underestimation of God. It is self-inflating, self-revolving, self-seeking, self-trusting.
