Title: Praise

Scripture: Psalm 147

Main Point: Praise is the worshipful response of a heart beholding the glorious goodness of who God is, who He has been, and who He will forever be.

Review:

Thanksgiving: Because we have tasted and seen the goodness of Christ in the gospel, we can joyfully give thanks to God in all seasons and circumstances for He is faithful.

Confession: Because God is merciful and gracious, we can humbly confess our sins knowing that He will make us clean and be our joy.

Lament: Lament is the path through the dark night of the soul.

Petition: The more rightly we understand who God is, the more fervent and bold we will be in our prayers.

- Praise is fitting, not because of a particular pleasant circumstance you find yourself in, but because of who He is at all times, in all seasons, and all circumstances.
