Title: Confronting our Complacency

Scripture: Amos 2

Main Point: God will not hesitate to confront His own people's complacency, exposing any prideful rejection of His Word, silencing any shifting of blame, and inviting us to remember His rescuing grace.

#7 - JUDAH

Charge:

- 1 Rejected the law of the Lord
- 2 Have not kept His statutes
- 3 Their lies have led them astray

Some of the lies Judah was buying into:

- <u>lie of pluralism</u> worship whoever you want: there's lots of options
- <u>lie of relative truth</u> this is what's true & works for me / you can do whatever 's true & works for you
- <u>lie of approving prosperity</u> our blessings are signs of God's endorsement
- <u>lie of false security</u> we're safe, strong, and invincible from threats
- <u>lie of compromising holiness</u> how we're living is just fine no big deal & no harm done

No one can save themself.

But Jesus can.

Stop looking around - examine your own heart.

Revival starts not 1st in confronting the unholiness of our culture, but in confronting the unholiness of our own hearts.

CALL TO ACTION:

- #1 Remember God's grace in humility Don't forget Him in pride
- #2 Make God's voice supreme Don't neglect His Word
- #3 Treat God's people with love Don't be hardened towards them
