**Title: What is Progressive Christianity?** 

**Scripture: Galatians 1:6-10** 

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Main Point: A post-modern distortion of the gospel called Progressive Christianity permeates our current culture, calling for our vigilant, humble, eager, and compassionate engagement with the true gospel in response.

**QUESTION #1** - Why do a series on false teaching? Why not just focus on the true gospel?

- 1. False Teaching is Prevalent
  - a. Matthew 24:4,11
  - b. We want to protect what is true so much that we're willing to take time to expose what is false
    - i. Ephesians 5:11
- 2. False Teaching is Treated Seriously
  - a. Galatians 1:6-9, 2:4-5
  - b. Ephesians 4:15-16
- 3. False Teachers are Treated as Threats
  - a. Acts 20:28-30
- 4. False Teaching is Demonically Driven
  - a. 1 Timothy 4:1-2
- 5. False Teaching is Alluring
  - a. 2 Corinthians 11:1-4,13-15
- 6. False Teachings are False Gospels
  - a. False Teachings pose a different problem than sin and offer a different solution than the cross of Jesus.
    - i. 2 Peter 2:1-3

QUESTION #2 - Why talk about a particular false teaching vs. false teaching in general?

- 1. False Teachings (and teachers) are specifically referenced and expolunded on in the Bible, not just generally talked about.
  - a. 2 Timothy 2:16-18
  - b. 1 Timothy 1:18-20

QUESTION #3 - Why focus on this particular one - Progressive Christianity?

1. It's Prevelant, 2. It's Aggressive, 3. It's Elusive

QUESTION #4 - Is the point to slam this teaching and people who believe it?

1. These people are not the enemy - they're sheep who need their Shepherd.

QUESTION #5 - Enough already... What is Deconstruction and Progressive Christianity?

# Theological Fruits of 'Deconstruction'

- 1. Bible oppose the Bible's reliability
- 2. Creation Affirm evolution and mythologize Gen. 1-2
- 3. Sin Hold shame & injustice as the great enemies, not sin and Satan (Original blessing vs. original sin)
- 4. Atonement See the substitutionary atonement of the cross as cruel. Jesus is simply an example of love.
- 5. Deity of Jesus De-emphasize or reject in favor of His humanity.
- 6. Trinity Move towards Panentheism: God is in all things and Christ is an energy
- 7. Resurrection Doubt or deny the physical resurrection of Jesus
- 8. Supernatural & Miracles Viewed with high skepticism and more metaphorical
- 9. God's Attributes Redefined or not defined at all
- 10. Hell & Final Judgment Rejected as not a real place. In the end, all people will be in heaven (universalism)
- 11. Religious Pluralism Believe all religious roads are leading to the same God.

## Cultural Fruits of 'Deconstruction'

- 1. Relativism & Tolerance
- 2. Redefine Gender & Sexuality
- 3. Wholly Embrace Critical Theory
- 4. Suspicion of Authority & Absolutes

# Common Language:

- "The Bible is a human book"
- "That's your interpretation"
- "What kind of God would \_\_\_\_? I can't believe in a God like that."
- "Marriage is about equality. Love is love."
- "Certainty is a sin. That's arrogant for you to think you have it figured out."
- "What's true for you is true for you you do you."
- "Why are you being so hateful & exclusive, we're after the same thing!"
- "Need to get with the times. Wrong side of history."
- "Questions are more important than answers. We're all on a faith journey."

### QUESTION #6 - What do we do with this?

- 1. Vigilance vs. Apathy Let's wake up to the seriousness.
- 2. Humility vs. Pride Let's examine our own hearts.
  - a. Progressive Christianity is particularly attractive to:

- i. Contemplative people
- ii. Empathetic, high mercy people
- iii. Dissatisfied and marginalized people especially women and minorities.
- iv. Hurt and wounded people, specifically from church.
- v. Confused people who have struggled for answers with clarity.
- vi. People who grew up in:
  - 1. Legalistic expressions of Christianity with lots of manmade traditions that felt suffocating or cultish even.
  - 2. Irrelevant, watered-down, fun and flashy versions of Christianity with no regard for depth and truth.
- b. If you don't genuinely do the humble work of self-examination, then you will do the hateful work of others-condemnation
- 3. Eagerness vs. Fear Let's lean in with faith & freedom.
  - a. 1. Thessalonians 5:21
- 4. Compassion vs. Coldness Let's engage people in love.
- 5. Praise vs Presumption Let's rejoice in the true gospel
