Start Praying!

"Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Through him we have also **obtained access** by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in the hope of the glory of God." **Romans 5:1-2 (Emphasis mine)**

"Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus, by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain, that is, through his flesh, and since we have a great high priest over the house of God, let us **draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith**, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. Main Idea: Prayer is Communion with God, and it is Essential to the Christian Life

I. Personal Prayer at Decided Times and in Specific Places

Daniel: "When Daniel knew that the document had been signed, he went to his house where he had windows in his upper chamber open toward Jerusalem. He got down on his knees three times a day and prayed and gave thanks before his God, **as he had done previously.**" **Daniel 6:10 (Emphasis mine)**

Paul: "I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers." Ephesians 1:16

Jesus: "Now Jesus was praying in a certain place, and when he finished, one of his disciples said to him, 'Lord, teach us to pray, as John taught his disciples.' And he said to them, 'When you pray, say: 'Father, hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come. Give us each day our daily bread, and forgive us our sins, for we ourselves forgive everyone who is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation."" Luke 11:1-4 (Emphasis mine)

II. Ceaseless Prayer in Constant Fellowship with God

III. Corporate Prayer with Fellow Believers Together
