

Faithful Moms and a Faithful God

2 Timothy 1:5-6a

“So she called the name of the Lord who spoke to her, “You are a God of seeing,” for she said, “Truly here I have seen him who looks after me.” Therefore the well was called Beer-lahai-roi; it lies between Kadesh and Bered.” **Genesis 16:13-14**

Main Idea: A Faithful Mom Sets the Stage for Faith to Grow

What is a faithful mom? A faithful mom is someone who knows the Gospel, lives out the gospel and prays fervently for her children!

“I am reminded of your sincere faith, a faith that dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice and now, I am sure, dwells in you as well. For this reason I remind you to fan into flame the gift of God,” **2 Timothy 1:5-6a**

Two important truths about Faithful Moms and a Faithful God:

I. We Celebrate Faithful Moms

“I am reminded of your sincere faith, a faith that dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice and now, I am sure, dwells in you as well.” **2 Timothy 1:5**

“But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have firmly believed, knowing from whom you learned it and how from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.” **2 Timothy 3:14-15**

II. We Trust God for Faithful Children

“For this reason, I remind you to fan into flame the gift of God,”

“I have no greater joy than to hear that my children are walking in the truth.” **3 John 1:4**

Seek the Lord daily, live a life that is honoring to Christ, pray for your children fervently, and allow God to do the rest.
