something for us in Christ.

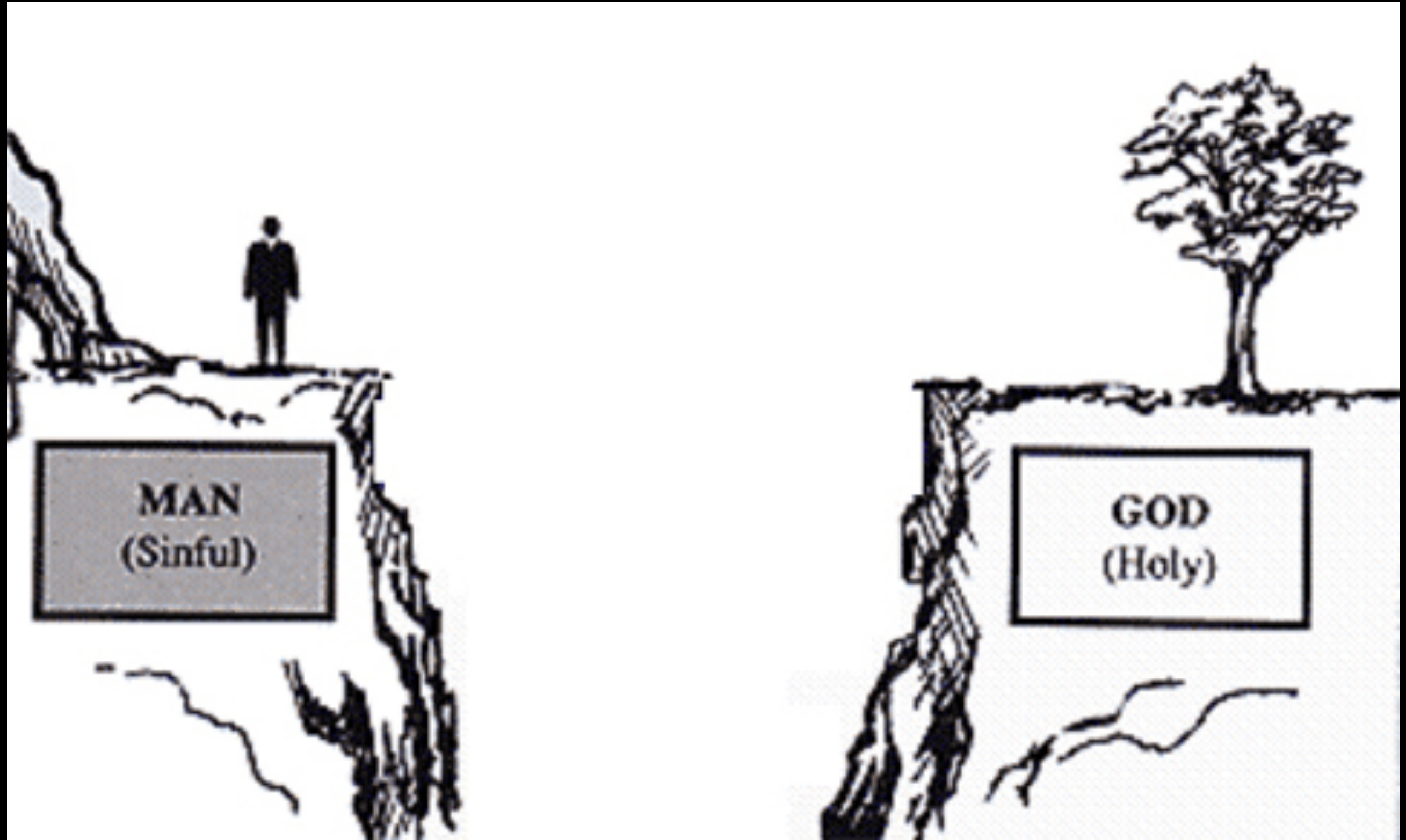

But he was pierced for **our** rebellion, crushed for **our** sins.

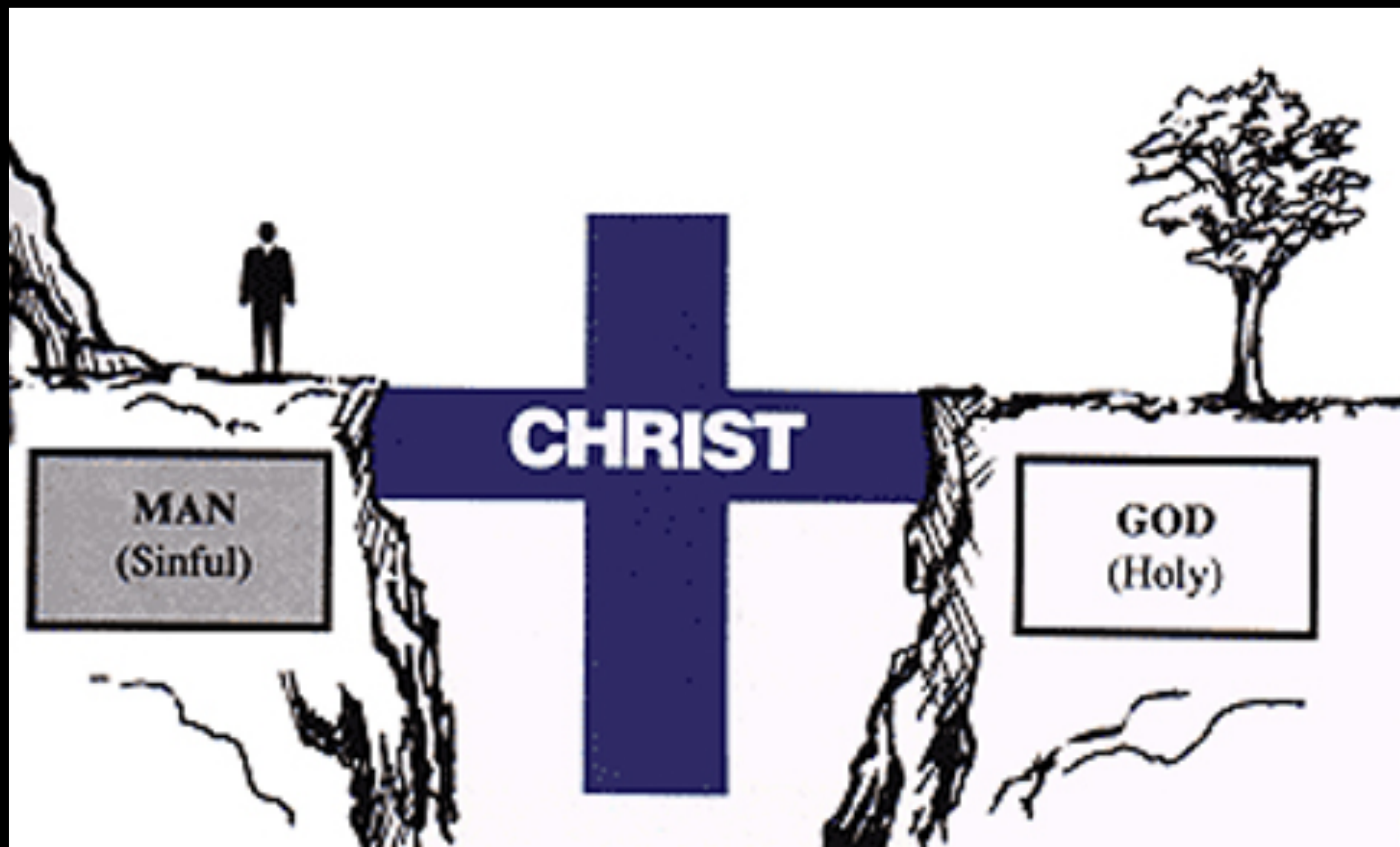
He was beaten so we could be whole. He was whipped so we could be healed. All of us, like sheep, have strayed away.
