Dear brothers and sisters,

As the year quickly progresses, I want to make you aware of some important upcoming events.

Chief Apostle Schneider will conduct a live webcast service from Mexico City on Sunday, August 7th. This service will take place at 11:30 am Eastern, 8:30 am Pacific, and be transmitted to all of North, Central, and South America. It is the climax of the Pan American Apostle conference, that will include all the Apostles from the western hemisphere who will be together for a conference with the Chief Apostle. Originally, we were scheduled to gather in Peru in 2020, however, due to the pandemic, our plans needed to be adjusted.

Additionally, we can also look forward to being together with the Chief Apostle for the Service for the Departed on November 6th, in Chicago. This service will take place at the Hyatt Regency hotel near Chicago O'Hare airport and will be webcast to all USA congregations. All are invited to attend this service in person; however, registration is first being opened to the surrounding districts until August 15th. After August 15th, those interested in attending the service should visit - nac-usa.org/Chicago, to register for the service and for hotel information.

There is something further I would like to share with you. As you may know, both Apostle John Fendt and I will go into retirement in 2023. Apostle Fendt will be retired in a Chief Apostle divine service on March 12th, and I, later in September of next year.

To prepare for this transition, Apostle John Schnabel, from New York, will be assigned as a District Apostle Helper in the divine service in Mexico on August 7th. This will allow him to work across the USA district and more closely with me in preparation to be my successor as the next District Apostle.

Please join with us in prayer as all the Apostles and I fervently work together to ensure the Lord's work in our district may continue to evolve and grow as we prepare for Christ's return.

And so, dear ones, I wish you a peaceful remainder of the summer and pray that we can deeply experience what God has in store for us through these special divine services, as our resolve is strengthened to step forward... together in Christ.
