Unfortunately, our sign needs a lot of work. The top part that contains our logo has yellowed, the lighting system is dim and our logo has changed. The middle section containing the LED display is broken beyond repair and needs to be replaced. We don't need a new sign from top to bottom but what we have needs major renovation work which will cost approximately \$33,000 to accomplish. We hope to raise this money soon so work can begin work before the end of the year.
