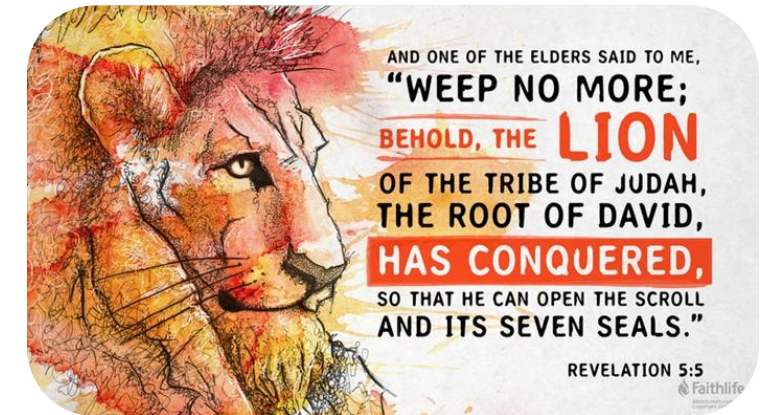
Our Children's Church will resume today for 4 year olds through 1st grade.
