We are thankful to Cecil Ledford and our safety team for the work they do each week to keep us safe as we gather, study the Bible and worship. Some of their work may not be immediately noticed but that is by design. They work faithfully behind the scenes to ensure everything is smooth on Sundays. They offer us a few reminders in the event of an emergency. If an armed intruder enters the sanctuary...

1. Lay down on the floor or the pew. Keep your head and body as low as possible and below the top of the pew.
2. Do NOT jump up and run and present yourself as a target. Stay low.
3. The safety team will take appropriate action so there is no need for anyone else to draw a weapon.

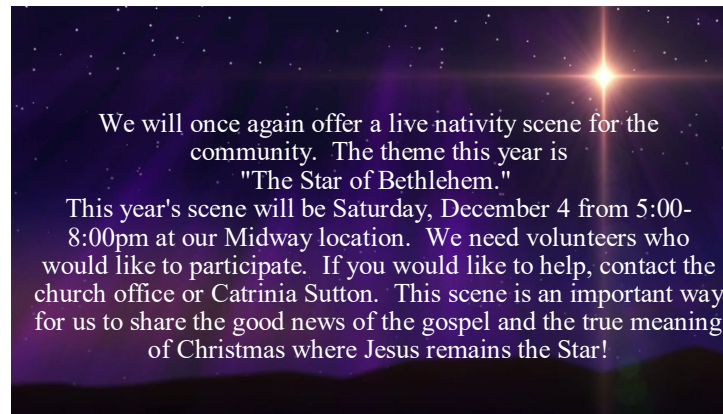

5. Wash and sanitize your hands often. Sanitizer and soap are abundantly available at our building.
6. The CDC's recent guidance recommends wearing a mask in indoor settings. If you feel more comfortable with a mask and wish to wear one, please do so. We respect your decision to do so.
